Article 110 1/1

- Article 110 of the proposed horizontal regulation introduces a common monitoring and evaluation framework for whole Common Agricultural Policy
 - Art. 74-86 of Rural Development regulation set specific requirements for Pillar II
 - Art. 41-50 of the Common Provisions regulation sets the overall requirements for all structural funds
- Monitoring and evaluation has to cover both pillars of CAP but consider specificities of each pillar
- Assessment against overall CAP objectives



Article 110 1/2

Commission proposal includes:

- Delegated act outlining the overall framework
- Implementing act laying down the common indicator
 - Impact indicators for the whole CAP
 - Result indicators for Pillar I
 - Output indicators for Pillar I

Nota Bene: Output and result indicators for Pillar II will be defined in a separate implementing act, covering Rural Development indicators

- Reporting on the **implementation** of the article every four years starting in 2017

DK Presidency proposal for Art. 110

- No delegated act - Clear description of Member States and Commission responsibilities
- Implementing act laying down the indicators
 - Impact indicators for the whole CAP
 - Result indicators for Pillar I
 - Output indicators for Pillar I
- Reporting on the **performance** of the CAP in 2018 and 2021



Implication for the upcoming work 2/1

- Uncertainty about legal basis leads to uncertainty about the next steps
- Some elements need to be developed anyhow:
 - Conceptual framework for monitoring and evaluating the CAP
 - including the joint assessment of both pillars
 - Establishment of common indicator lists
 - Drafting related implementing/ delegated acts

All this will be done in cooperation with the Member States



Implication for the upcoming work 2/2

Consultations

September 2011 - Stakeholder conference on monitoring and evaluating the CAP

12 June 2012 - Evaluation Expert Committee on impact indicators and evaluation (Pillar II only)

14 June 2012 – First meeting of expert group on monitoring and evaluating the CAP

20 June 2012 - Consultation of Rural Development Committee + Funds Committee on list of indicators (Rural Development only)

Early Oct. 2012 - Next meeting foreseen for this expert group

first exchange on content for the implementing/ delegated acts
