MINUTES CARE MEETING

7 DECEMBER 2012

1. CARE and CADaS Developments

The EC presented the point 1 on the agenda and all the PP has been uploaded on Circa. There is still some data missing for 2011, some countries have not been able to provide the dataset on time due mainly to changes on their databases or in the methodology for data collection. Direct contact with LT and CY will be organized.

EC presented the situation on the CaDAS datamodel and encouraged MS that don't yet use it to start the process. The EC will work bilaterally with the individual MS.

The CARE-viewer tool has been presented and the participants generally responded very positively. Future use of the tool for TEN-network has been advanced. The application is protected with login/password and all necessary information has been sent to all CARE experts.

The on-going work on an injury strategy was shortly presented.

Several comments and questions were raised by the participants, sharing experiences of MS progress so far and requesting more information about the policy options ahead.

The EC explained that the old system should be continuing to run in parallel so that data is not risked. It was proposed that common algorithm for converting ICD codes to AIS could be a starting point for a joint translation system.

As conclusion: the situation varies a lot on MS and it was a general agreement on the necessity to have a clear view on that subject. The proposal to send a questionnaire to MS was generally accepted.

2. Presentation of final results of the DaCOTA project.

A general overview as well as detailed information on the WP of the project were presented. Reports on country profiles, forecast, basic fact sheets, accidents investigation manuals and pilot on naturalistic driving are now available on the Dacota website and will be transferred to the Europa site. Road safety management country reports will be sent for validation before being published on Europa.
