**Summary of the Seventh meeting of the IDSG Expert Team**  
**1 October 2012, 12:30 to 17:00**  
**EUROCONTROL HQ - Brussels**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

- **Administrative issues:** Collection of invoices related to the travel and subsistence expenses, to be reimbursed by the Commission in accordance with the provisions in force.
- **Refreshing the conclusions from the IDSG/ET/6:** IDSG ET Chair, Mr Nicolas Warinsko gave a debriefing on the status of developments related to SESAR Deployment and highlighted the progress since ET/6:
  - The consolidation of the IDP has been completed, (in terms of WBS and Gantt chart) with submission of IDP v0.2 to IDSG.
  - IDSG forwarded IDP v0.2 to EC, with minor updates.
  - EC returned a positive opinion to IDSG. However, there is a need to include geographical applicability and timing as well as an initial analysis (“reality check”) to build a full picture for the SSC

**2. INTERIM DEPLOYMENT PROGRAMME (IDP)**

- Stakeholder feedback by correspondence on the draft IDP v1.0 was discussed and integrated.
- A first draft NM view of the detailed IDP geographical applicability and target deployment by WP was analysed with a view to update for ET/8
  - Applicability area
    - Details on the geographical applicability based on ESSIP, NOS and NOP
  - Timing
    - ESSIP planning time info available based on FOC plus available info from ANSP and NM – reconciliation still needed
    - May need to adapt to IDP timeframe once applicability agreed

**3. IDP EXECUTION**

- Stakeholder feedback by correspondence on the draft interim IDSG Report on IDP content was discussed and integrated.
  - ANSP provided a consolidated ANSP IDP applicability view
  - Initiated mitigation of inconsistencies with the NM view
- “Kicked-off “reality check” based on the initial estimated applicability

**3. EXPERT TEAM’S WORK PROGRAMME (UPDATE)**

- Early Oct: Draft 1.0 to SSC
- Early Nov: ET/8 focused on the outcome of the « reality check » + finalising report to IDSG/4
