Mission: The group advises the Commission and the Directors of Agricultural Statistics (DGAS) in all relevant matters in the statistical domain of animal production (including statistics on organic farming that fall under its remit). Being part of the governance system of the European Statistical System, the group shall assist in preparing technical proposals in the area of animal production statistics (including statistics on organic farming that fall under its remit) prior to the decisions to be taken by DGAS and the European Statistical System Committee (ESSC). The group discusses and agrees methodology in the area of animal production statistics (including statistics on organic farming that fall under its remit), identifies best practices and discusses quality improvements. The group discusses Eurostat's work planning in the area of animal production statistics (including statistics on organic farming that fall under its remit), ensuring improved data availability and quality. The group is a platform to exchange know-how between countries and to co-operate at European level and with international organisations.

Council Directive (96/16/EC) of 19 March 1996 on statistical surveys of milk and milk products. Commission Decision (97/80/EC) of 18 December 1996 laying down provisions for the implementation of Council Directive 96/16/EC on statistical surveys of milk and milk products.

Other

Origin: The working Group on Animal Production Statistics results from joining in 2005 the Working Group on Animal Products Statistics and Milk and milk products statistics, both mandated by the Standing Committee on Agricultural Statistics (CPSA). The scope of the Working Group covers the statistics on agricultural production of products drawn from animals together with statistics on organic farming that fall under its remit. The statistics on the production factors (livestock for breeding, renewal, dairy and laying) and the stocks (fattened animals) are covered. Animal production outside agricultural (aquaculture, fishing and hunting) is out of its scope.
