### **Activity Report**

The overall coordination between EACEA A7 and DG EAC falls under the responsibility of Directorate A. The responsibility for coordination within DG EAC lies with Unit A4 'Evidence-based policy and Evaluation'. The operational coordination of the Eurydice Network is the responsibility of EACEA A7. These rules are drafted by EACEA A1, in close cooperation with EACEA A7 for content related issues, and approved by DG EAC A.
