Activity Report

The meeting of Contact Group on Legal Migration - encompassing the Contact Group on LTR - took place in Brussels on 13 December 2010 with the participation of Member States experts as well as the European Parliament. The meeting provided the opportunity for a useful exchange of views between national experts involved in the transposition of the legal migration directives. More particularly, as regards the LTR Directive, question on the notion of permits 'formally limited' in the meaning of Art. 3(2)(e) of Directive 2003/109/EC was raised, in relation with family members. The next meeting was on 5 October 2011 as part of the general contact group on legal migration. As far as LTR was concerned, the discussion focussed on whether a person could be entitled to both an LTR residence permit and a family reunification permit, and the relationship between expulsion of a person holding an LTR permit and the Return Directive

Selection Procedure (members)
