Selection Procedure (members)

Mandate end 31/10/2016 : The group of experts consists of 20 members appointed in accordance with Article 3 of the above Decision who are qualified individuals selected by the Commission on the basis of their expertise in the area of financial services. The Commission has assessed the eligibility of individual experts against the following criteria: — minimum 4 years of professional experience in the financial services sector, at least 2 of which on user-related issues, — proficiency in English, a language which is customary in the sphere of finance, at a level which allows the expert to participate in discussions and draft reports in that language, — availability to participate in meetings approximately 8 times a year and commitment to work extensively between meetings to prepare the output of the group (opinions, position papers, reports etc.). In making the final selection of group members on the basis of the submitted proposals, the Commission has taken into account the need to obtain input from individuals appointed to represent the interests of consumers, retail investors or micro-enterprises on the one hand, and individual experts on the other. In addition, the Commission has endeavoured to ensure that the Group contains a balance between expertise in all sectors of financial services and an adequate geographical coverage within the European Union.
