Activity Report

On Friday 4 May 2012 a security exercise was held in the port of Antwerp in the presence of observers from the Member States and European Commission. This was an inter-disciplinary "tabletop" exercise in which various scenarios were simulated in the Coordination Centre, with interaction between the local Antwerp committee and the National Authority for Maritime Security.

Selection Procedure (members)

The members of the group are the 28 EU Member States, plus Norway and Iceland. The members of the group are nominated by the national competent authority in the field of maritime security on the basis of their expertise, qualifications and experience.
