Selection Procedure (members)

The Advisory group members were selected from the database established by the Call for expressions of interest for the selection of experts for the Horizon 2020 Advisory group. Following criteria was taken into account: Proven competence and experience of the individual candidate or, of the designated representatives from organisations, including at European and/or international level, in area of the challenge. Proven competence and experience of the individual candidate or, of the designated representatives from organisations, in horizontal expertise, including cross-cutting issues of relevance to Horizon 2020. In addition, for individuals appointed to represent a stakeholder interest, the proven capacity of the candidate to represent effectively the position shared by stakeholders, and for individuals appointed to represent an organisation, the competence, experience and hierarchical level of the proposed representative. The final composition of the group takes into account the need to ensure balanced participation in terms of representativeness of stakeholders, gender, age and geographical origin (without calling into question the necessary level of expertise and insight). The experts of the group will be designated in accordance with the EC Decision C(2011)1132 OJ L75.
