Selection Procedure (members)

The members of this group are Member States' experts (type D). Since the Regulation 2016/679 is a text with EEA relevance and the Directive 2016/680 is a development of the Schengen acquis, experts from EEA countries (Iceland, Lichtenstein and Norway) and from Switzerland will also be members of the group (type E). The members of the expert group shall be appointed on ad hoc basis, depending on the meeting agenda of the group, but the number will always be the same (28 Member States +4). The experts on Regulation 2016/679 predominantly come from Justice departments of national administration, while the experts on Directive 2016/680 predominantly come from Internal affairs departments of national administration.
