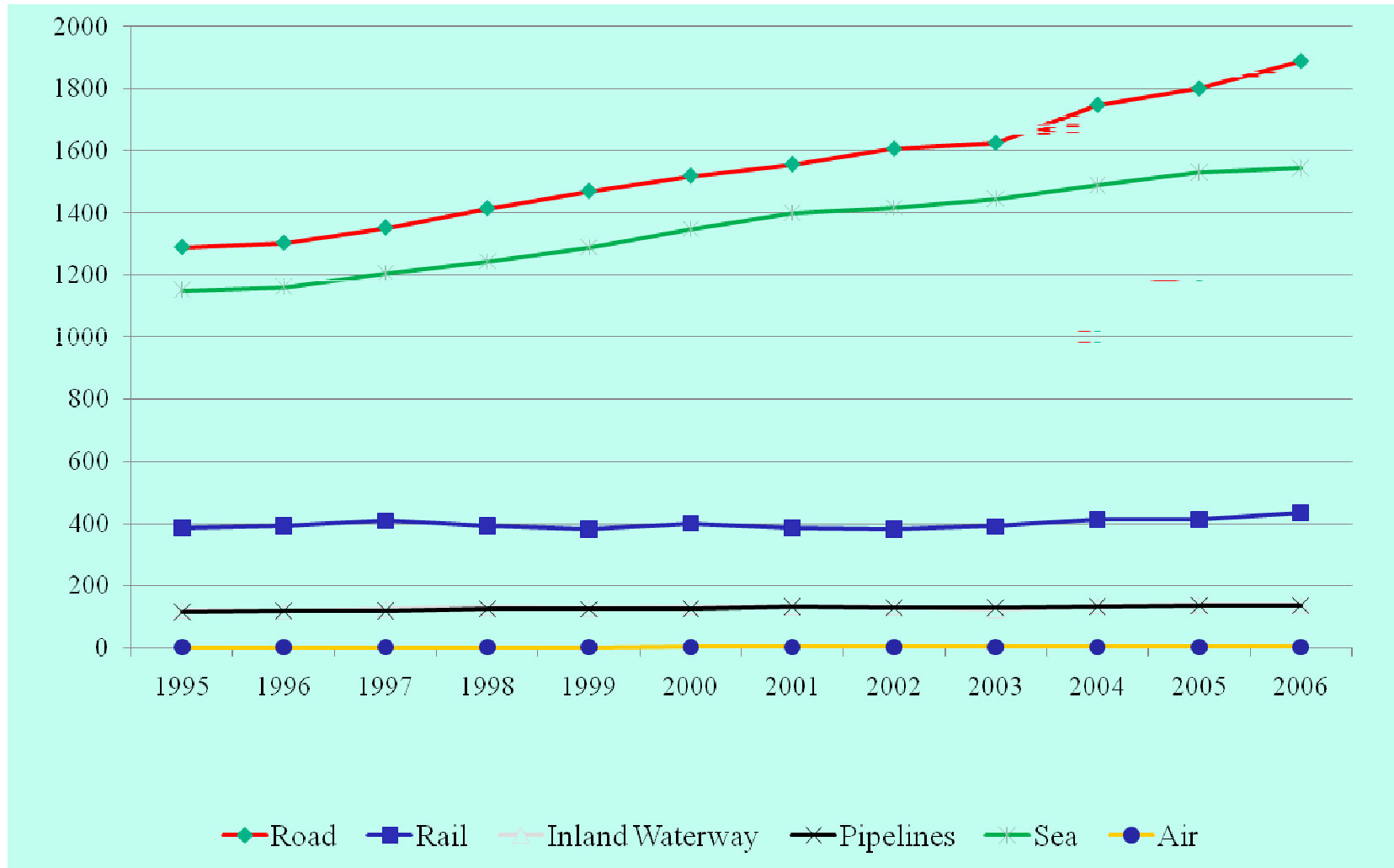

billion tonne-kilometres



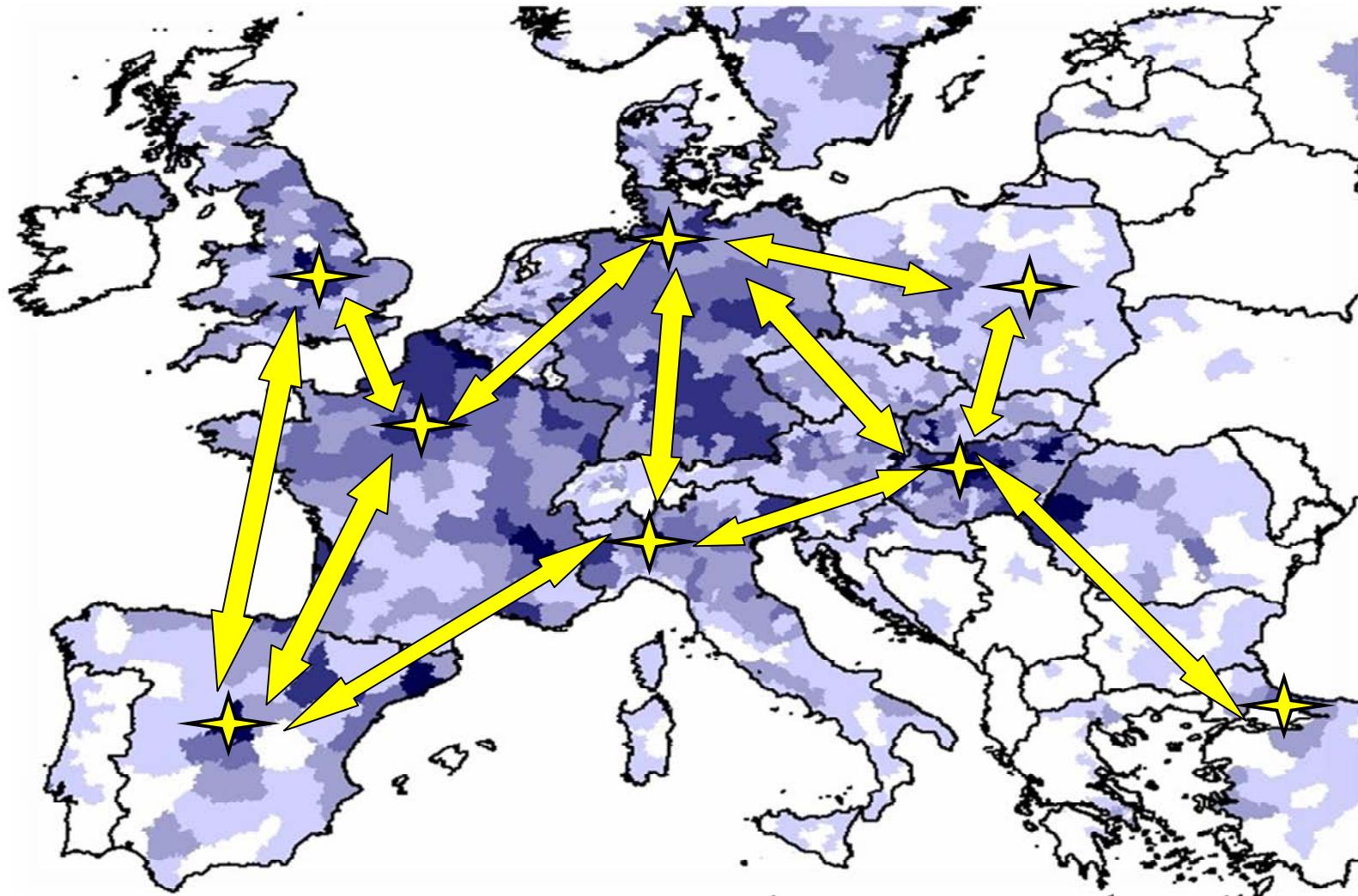
## Necessary actions in the regulatory environment

---

---

- Market regulation: equal opportunities in the transport sectors
- Regulation of transport: transport licensing, the conditions of freight transport
- Taxation: fuel taxes, vehicle taxes, tolls
- Environmental regulation: emission specifications, rationalization of energy consumption
- Technical regulation: requirements relevant to vehicles and infrastructure
- Welfare regulation: driving time and resting time
