**Subject: Summary report of the 21<sup>st</sup> Committee meeting for direct payments held on 10/12/2015**

Chairman: Nicolas Clisson

**1. INTEGRATED ADMINISTRATION AND CONTROL SYSTEM (IACS):**

Presentation and exchanges of view on a Working document on the increase in the percentage of beneficiaries to be checked in the context of greening where significant non-compliances are found - **DS/CDP/2015/19-Rev 1**

The Commission representatives presented the revised version of the draft working document stated above. The main changes compared to the previous version were highlighted. Member States (MS) expressed their opinion about this revised document and raised additional questions/comments to which the Commission representatives provided explanations/clarifications. Moreover, the Commission services undertook the commitment to further examine certain issues raised by several delegations with a view to finalising the document in the course of January 2016.

**2. ANY OTHER BUSINESS:**

A request has been raised by one Member State to amend an ISAMM notification form (No 505 - Main policy decisions, financial allocations and redistributive payment from 2016) with a deadline for sending information on 1 August 2015. The Member State claims that as a consequence of Regulation (EU) No 747/2015 - derogation to the final date for submission of single application, aid application, etc. - there was only little time to process the applications and to evaluate the needs for the young farmer payment from 2016 onwards. More in particular, the request is to modify the percentages of the national envelope allocated to the young farmer payment and to overbooking of the Basic Payment Scheme from 2016.

The Commission representative explained that the deadlines for taking the decisions which are subject to the notification obligations concerned are set in Regulation (EU) No 1307/2013. The Commission has no power to derogate from such deadlines, except on the basis of Article 69 of Regulation (EU) No 1307/2013. The use of such provision is however limited to specific problems that need to be resolved on the grounds of emergency, which was found not to be the case.
