#### **B. POINTS FOR INFORMATION AND/OR DISCUSSION**

##### **1. Authorisation of non-organic agricultural ingredients- withdrawal and addition: overview of comments received from Member States**

The European Commission presented the summary of requests for withdrawals and requests for additions to Annex IX to Regulation 889/2008. Methodology of providing and assessing these requests was agreed.

##### **2. Baby food: presentation by the Commission**

The Commission presented the horizontal rules (DG SANTE) applying to “baby food” and their articulation with the current and future rules on organic production.

Several Member States asked for clarifications on several issues regarding the future organic rules.

The Commission invited the Member States who had not already done so to send their questions related to “baby food” so they can be dealt with, where possible, at the next COP.

The Commission will upload the presentation on CIRCA BC.

### **3. Working document: back-log implementing act on current legislation overview of comments received from Member States**

The Commission explained how Member States comments were incorporated in the document

### **4. Organic reform-delegated and implementing acts-identification of the needs on production rules: overview of comments received from Member States**

BE, CZ, DK, FR, PL, SE, and the UK provided additional comments based on which the EC considers activating additional empowerments for this thematic group.

### **5. Organic reform: technical discussion on poultry production rules**

The Commission presented the methodology which will be used to develop implementing acts based on the organic reform for poultry production rules.

The Commission invited Member States to work on the technical points on poultry production rules relevant to the drafting of the implementing act.

A technical discussion on poultry production rules will take place at the next COP.

The European Commission will upload the presentation on CIRCA BC.

### **6. Letters of interpretation relevant for the COP**

The Commission explained the reply to the South Africa request for Carnauba wax on citrus.

SE was requested to provide more information on micro-organisms not normally used.??

### **7. EGTOP overview of mandates**

Mandates and draft mandates were updated based on Member States' comments. Programme for the remaining part of 2018 was finalized

### **8. Follow up to irregularities and fraud allegations in the EU**

## **9. Catalogue of measures in case of irregularities and infringements<sup>1</sup>**

The Commission provided an overview of the history of committee proceedings under which Member States were invited to share with one another their catalogues in order to start discussions with a view to converge the rules. The Commission recalled that it was interested in the positive outcome of such an exercise and offered its facilitation in 2017, including a shared IT platform CIRCA and English translations of all received catalogues.

In order to generate debate the Commission also provided a review of a sample of measures concerning general irregularities/infringements, irregularities/infringements in plant production, animal production/welfare and imports.

Intervening delegations (AT, BE, DE, ES, FI, IE, IT, NO, PL) provided updates, shared experience, and recognised the need for action.

## **10. Commission positions concerning controls and supervision, discussions**

### 1) Documentary evidence (Annex XII of Regulation (EC) No 889/2008)

The Commission shared its position on the harmonised form of the documentary evidence and additional national rules.

### 2) Approval/supervision of control bodies established in other Member States

The Commission shared its position based on the rulings of the European Court of Justice.

## **11. Follow up to irregularities and fraud allegations on imported products**

The Commission withdrew this item from the agenda.
