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EU RURAL DEVELOPMENT MONITORING DATA –

SYNTHESIS REPORT FOR 2001

INTRODUCTION

Commission Regulation (EC) No 445/2002 laying down the implementing rules for Council Regulation (EC) No 1257/1999 on support for rural development from the EAGGF, states that Member States should submit annual progress reports to the Commission, which should include monitoring information in the form of quantitative indicators.

In the conclusions of the Agricultural Council to the European Council at Göteborg in July 2001, the Council invited the Commission: *"to make a short summary of the yearly reports made by the Member States of their rural development programmes as set out in Regulation (EC) No 1257/1999 based on national synthesis made by the Member States, and present the results every two years starting in 2002."*

This document is the first Community-level summary report on rural development.

BACKGROUND

It has not been possible to produce this summary report until now because of delays in the submission, validation, and correction where necessary, of Member States' monitoring data. By 30 June 2002 (the deadline for submission of rural development annual reports and monitoring indicators for 2001) data had been received in electronic form for less than half of the rural development programmes, and the remaining data were submitted gradually over the course of the next months.

The first common set of monitoring indicators was drawn up in 1999–2000. After receiving the data for the year 2000, however, several difficulties and inconsistencies in completing the tables became apparent. As a result, the monitoring tables were reviewed, and a simplified and streamlined set of indicators was agreed with Member States. This new format was to be used in future years as well as for re-submission of 2000 data. Detailed explanatory guidelines for completion of the tables were also prepared by the Commission.

The new tables have led to a significant improvement in the quality and quantity of data supplied by Member States in their annual reports for 2001 and the data now offer a good basis for aggregation and comparison. Nevertheless, there is still substantial scope for improvement and a number of errors and omissions of varying degrees of importance are found in the data provided by Member States.

Where errors or omissions are particularly significant, they are noted in the body of this report or as footnotes to the tables. Inconsistencies in the financial data provided are particularly prevalent. For example, for those measures where the total eligible cost is requested, the figure provided is often not equal, as it should be, to the total public expenditure committed plus the total costs borne by the beneficiaries (see measures (g), (h), (i) and Article 33). For this reason, this report concentrates on public expenditure data only, which is likely to be more accurate.

AMOUNT OF DATA RECEIVED

For the 2000–2006 programming period, there are 67 rural development programmes co-financed by the EAGGF-Guarantee Section (RDPs) for which reports are required. Also co-financed by EAGGF-Guarantee are the non-accompanying measures included in 20 Objective 2 Structural Funds programmes that are exclusive to France. In addition, there are 69 Objective 1 Structural Funds programmes with non-accompanying measures, co-financed by EAGGF-Guidance.

Non-accompanying measures included within Structural Funds Objective 1 and 2 programming are subject to separate reporting requirements under Structural Funds rules. However, a separate, adapted set of tables has been provided specifically for these measures, and the Commission has strongly recommended its use as part of the relevant Structural Fund annual report. This would allow a full overview of the total rural development effort (EAGGF Guarantee and Guidance co-financing), both at national and Community level.

Table 1 in the Annex summarises the status of data reception for years 2000 and 2001. There are two main gaps: (1) 2000 data are still to be resubmitted in the new format for over 85% of programmes; and (2) very little data for the non-accompanying measures within Objective 1 Structural Fund programmes have been received for either year. As a result, **it is only possible in this report to cover the 87 programmes with Guarantee funding, and only for the year 2001.**

DATA AND DISCUSSION

This report uses as its **exclusive data source** the common monitoring indicator data for each of the **87 programmes with EAGGF-Guarantee financing**. Its purpose is to summarise the monitoring data provided for 2001 and it makes no reference to any other source of information, such as the written annual reports or other qualitative data.

The tables shown in the Annex are adaptations of the common indicator tables, altered to allow comparison between Member States. The data were obtained by aggregation of the indicators submitted by national or regional administrations for each of the 87 programmes. For those Member States with more than one RDP, data from all the programmes within that Member State were first aggregated to provide overall national figures.

Detailed information on the exact definitions of the data featured in the common monitoring indicator tables can be found in the Explanatory Guidelines at: http://europa.eu.int/comm/agriculture/rur/eval/index_en.htm. However, two points are important to note here:

1. The data only concern the present programming period, 2000–2006 (i.e. agreements under Council Regulation (EC) No 1257/1999); ongoing commitments from the previous programming period are not listed.
2. Expenditure data concern commitments made rather than actual payments. For most measures, the total expenditure for each project approved in 2001 is shown, regardless of when the project will be realised or whether payments will be spread over several years. For those measures involving multi-annual commitments (early retirement, less favoured areas and areas with environmental restrictions, agri-environment and afforestation), the appropriate *annual share* of expenditure committed is shown for each project approved or ongoing in 2001, rather than the total.

OVERVIEW

Table 2 in the Annex gives an overview of the measures included in Member States' rural development programmes (EAGGF-Guarantee funded) showing those actually implemented (X) as well as those that are part of the programmes, but were not implemented in 2001 (NI). For those Member States with more than one RDP, data from all the programmes within that Member State has been merged to provide a national picture. Aside from agri-environment (compulsory), the most prevalent measures in terms of the number of Member States implementing them were support for less-favoured areas (14 MS), afforestation (12 MS) and training (12 MS). The least implemented measure was support for areas with environmental restrictions (3 MS).

The total public expenditure committed to rural development programmes in the EU in 2001, broken down by measure, is shown in Table 3 in the Annex. The total for all 87 programmes covered by this report stood at €7,965 million, of which €3,467 million was from the EAGGF-Guarantee section. Support for less favoured areas (€2,346 million, of which €862 million was from the EAGGF) and agri-environment (€1,735 million, of which €937 million was from the EAGGF) were the measures for which the most public expenditure was committed in 2001. The public expenditure for individual measures is discussed in more detail with the tables for each measure in the Annex.

In Table 4 in the Annex, the total public expenditure by each Member State is shown, broken down according to (A) structural fund designation and (B) less-favoured area classification. The breakdowns clearly vary significantly between Member States, depending on the nature of their territory. Nevertheless, in the EU as a whole, 14 per cent of EAGGF-Guarantee expenditure was committed in Objective 1 areas, and 35 per cent in Objective 2. Of the total Guarantee expenditure, 59 per cent was committed in the various less favoured areas, and 29 per cent in normal areas. However, note that a significant proportion of the expenditure under both classifications is shown in the "correction" column. This column was introduced because for many programmes, some or all of the data required to complete the tables was not available. In other cases, the data provided did not agree with that provided in the tables for the individual measures. The "correction" column allows the totals in Table 4 to match those from the individual measures tables (below).

Table 4 does not provide a good basis for comparison of total public expenditure between Member States, as it shows Guarantee-section expenditure only, and not Guidance (which funds non-accompanying measures in Objective 1 areas). Table 5 in the Annex provides a better basis for comparison by being restricted to total public expenditure on accompanying measures, which are funded exclusively by Guarantee in all areas, including Objective 1. Austria, Finland and Germany committed the greatest public expenditure to accompanying measures in 2001. Finland also committed the highest expenditure per capita, per holding and per hectare of utilised agricultural area (UAA), in all cases by a significant margin in comparison with other Member States. The lowest expenditure on accompanying measures per capita and per ha UAA was in the Netherlands, while the lowest expenditure per holding was in Italy.

INDIVIDUAL MEASURES (A – V)

Each individual rural development measure is discussed below and accompanied by Tables 6–31 in the Annex.

A. INVESTMENT IN AGRICULTURAL HOLDINGS (Ch. I, Art. 4–7) – Table 6

This measure was implemented for 40 out of the 87 programmes in 11 member states in 2001 (EAGGF-Guarantee financing only – no Objective 1), with a total of 33 792 applications approved, involving a public expenditure commitment of €72 million, of which €17 million (32%) was from the EAGGF.

The Member State that committed the greatest expenditure was Italy (€285 million, of which €1 million from the EAGGF). The average public expenditure for investments in agricultural holdings was €19 872, and this value ranged between €8 896 in France and €6 131 in the United Kingdom. The average aid intensity (percentage of total eligible cost that is public expenditure) was 31%, and 9% of the total eligible cost was allocated to investments with the primary aim of protecting and enhancing the environment.

B. SETTING-UP OF YOUNG FARMERS (Ch. II, Art. 8) – Table 7

This measure was implemented in 9 Member States in 2001 (32 of the 87 programmes), with a total of 16, 795 applications approved for support for the setting-up of young farmers. Nearly half of these (7 902) were from Italy, which also committed the greatest expenditure. The total public expenditure commitment was €75 million, of which €172 million (46%) was from the EAGGF. The balance of expenditure between single premia and interest subsidies varied among the Member States.

Overall, the applications were fairly evenly split between the four age categories, although there was some variation between Member States, with France and Spain predominantly supporting farmers under 30 and Italy and Austria predominantly supporting farmers between 30 and 40. The average amount of support per farmer was €22 314, but this value ranged significantly between €9 136 in Austria and €46 744 in Belgium.

C. TRAINING (Ch. III, Art. 9) – Table 8

This measure was implemented in 12 member states in 2001 (31 of the 87 programmes), with 18 924 applications approved for support for training, involving a total of 477 817 participants. While nearly half of applications approved were from Belgium, these only involved 24 124 participants, while the many fewer applications approved in Spain involved over 7 times as many (178 462 participants). The total public expenditure committed in 2001 for the training measure was €76.5 million (of which €28.6 million (37%) was from the EAGGF), and the average cost per participant was €160. This figure varied from €11 per participant in Spain to €362 in Finland. These large variations suggests significant differences between the training programmes designed in different Member States and/or programmes. However, any firm inferences are hampered by a significant number of inconsistencies in the financial data provided (see above).

D. EARLY RETIREMENT (Ch. IV, Art. 10–12) – Table 9

Support for early retirement from farming was implemented in only 7 Member States (28 of the 67 programmes that include accompanying measures), primarily in Southern Europe. There were 6 778 ongoing agreements in 2001, of which 4 933 were new applications that year and two-thirds (4 476) were from Spain. These agreements have or will result in the release of a total of 179 205 hectares, including 1 198 ha reassigned to non-agricultural uses.

The vast majority of agreements (6 266) were for support to farmers rather than farm workers. The average amount of support committed (annual share) was €4 121 for farmers and €2 368 for farm workers, and the total amount of public expenditure committed was €27 million (of which €17.4 million (64%) was from the EAGGF).

E.1 LESS-FAVoured AREAS (CH. V, Art. 13–21) – Table 10

Support for less favoured areas was a widespread measure, implemented in all Member States apart from Belgium in 2001 (47 of the 67 programmes that include accompanying measures). It was also the measure with the highest public expenditure committed, at € 346 million, of which €62 million (37%) was from the EAGGF.

In total, over a million holdings were supported by less-favoured areas payments, covering an area of 33.3 million hectares. This amounted to an average payment of € 319 per holding or €71 per hectare. While distribution within each Member State varied depending on the characteristics of the country, overall, the holdings supported were divided evenly between mountain areas and other less-favoured areas. In addition, a small minority (6%) of holdings supported were in areas affected by specific handicaps.

Information on the number of holdings and the area supported that were within Natura 2000 areas was requested for each programme, but due to a lack of data available for these indicators for a significant number of programmes, no conclusions can be drawn from the data.

E.2 AREAS WITH ENVIRONMENTAL RESTRICTIONS (CH. V, Art. 16) – Table 11

In sharp contrast to less favoured areas, support for areas with environmental restrictions was the least prevalent of all measures, with only Germany, Italy and Spain implementing it (11 of the 67 programmes that include accompanying measures). Only 4 156 holdings received payments under Article 16 of Regulation (EC) No 1257/1999 in 2001, covering a total 58 000 ha. The vast majority (95%) of the holdings supported were in Germany (3 948). Although the measure was reported to be implemented as part of two Italian programmes, no holdings were reported to be supported in Italy.

Average payments were € 366 per holding or €8 per hectare, with a total public expenditure committed of €5.68 million (of which €3.24 million was from the EAGGF).

Information on the number of holdings and the area supported that were within Natura 2000 areas is incomplete.

F. AGRI-ENVIRONMENT (CH. VI, Art. 22–24) – Table 12

Article 43(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1257/1999 states that "in their [rural development] plans, Member States shall provide for agri-environment measures throughout their territories". This measure was therefore implemented in all 15 Member States. However, it was only implemented in 53 of the 67 programmes that include accompanying measures. This is because Spain and Finland apply a horizontal programme for accompanying measures, which are therefore not featured in all their other programmes. In addition, due to a high level of ongoing commitments from the previous programming period in 6 Italian regions, the agri-environment measure was yet to be implemented in 2001, though it will be implemented in the future.

There were nearly 1.1 million ongoing contracts in 2001, of which 866 411 (81%) were new in 2001. The contracts covered a total of 19 million hectares, although note that this figure does not take account of possible double counting if the same area of land is covered by more than one agreement. An estimate of the area under agri-environment contracts without double counting (and the amount of this within Natura 2000 areas) is included as part of the common monitoring tables, but will not be discussed in this report due to a poor response for these indicators.

Total public expenditure committed to agri-environment measures in 2001 (annual share) was € 727 million. This figure is less than the expenditure committed to support less-favoured areas, although the contribution from the EAGGF was larger at €32 million (see e.1 above).

Within the agri-environment measure, 60 943 contracts (6% of all contracts) were categorised as predominantly relating to organic farming, covering 1 456 million ha and accounting for €71 million of the public expenditure commitment.

The average annual premium per ha was €89, but this ranged between €32/ha in France and €46/ha in Greece. For organic contracts, the average premium was €186, and this ranged between €45/ha in the UK and €445/ha in Greece.

In addition, there were 8 442 contracts to support breeds in danger of being lost to farming, covering 60 568 livestock units and involving a commitment of €8.25 million of public money.

G. IMPROVING PROCESSING AND MARKETING OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS (CH. VII, Art. 25–28) – Table 13

This measure was implemented for 48 out of the 87 programmes in 10 Member States in 2001 (EAGGF-Guarantee financing only – no Objective 1). 1 612 applications were approved, with over 80% coming from France (269), Italy (363) and Spain (688). The total public expenditure committed was €462 million (€228 million (49%) of which was from the EAGGF), giving an average per project of €287 000.

Approximately 3 per cent of applications and public expenditure were primarily aimed at improving the processing and marketing of organic products, while 4 per cent of the total eligible costs were allocated to "green" investments – those with the primary aim of protecting and enhancing the environment, livestock hygiene or animal welfare. However, note that data was not available for these indicators for some programmes.

H. AFFORESTATION OF AGRICULTURAL LAND AND I. OTHER FORESTRY MEASURES (CH. VIII, Art. 30–32) – Tables 14–17

The afforestation of agricultural land was implemented in 12 Member States (37 of the 67 programmes that include accompanying measures), while other forestry measures were implemented in 10 Member States (34 of the 87 programmes).

The forestry measures are summarised in four tables. The first of these shows planting costs for afforestation (Table 14). In 2001, 17 074 applications were approved for planting costs, comprising 13 434 on agricultural land and 3 640 in other areas. These applications covered a total of 450 000 ha, over 96 per cent of which was agricultural land. The average amount of support was €334 per ha for agricultural land and €791 per ha for other afforestation. Nearly 90 percent of the applications were for afforestation of privately-owned land. However, inconsistencies in the financial information provided for some programmes, in particular the distinction between publicly- and privately-owned land, prevent any detailed discussion of the financial data for this measure.

The second table shows agreements to grant premia to cover maintenance costs and loss of income for the afforestation of privately-owned agricultural land (Table 15). 8 781 maintenance costs agreements and 8 661 income loss agreements were ongoing in 2001, covering 72 000 and 603 000 ha respectively. €19.7 million of public expenditure was committed to maintenance cost premia and €69.1 million to income loss (annual shares). This translates to average annual payments of €74 and €15 per ha respectively, although the amounts paid vary considerably among the Member States.

The third table shows other forestry measures under Article 30 (indents 2–5) of Regulation (EC) No 1257/1999 (investments in forestry and forestry products, forest fire prevention etc.) – (Table 16). 40 259 applications were approved in 2001, involving a public expenditure commitment of €81 million (of which €19 million (38%) was from the EAGGF).

The final table (Table 17) shows other forestry measures under Article 32 of Regulation (EC) No 1257/1999 (maintenance of ecological stability of forests and fire breaks) – Table 17). 4 975 applications were approved in 2001, involving a public expenditure commitment of €6.76 million (of which €3.31 million (49%) was from the EAGGF). A total of 501 000 ha were covered, at an average of 101 ha per application.

J. TO V. PROMOTING THE ADAPTATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF RURAL AREAS (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 18

The measures set out in Article 33 of Regulation (EC) No 1257/1999 are targeted towards the adaptation and development of rural areas. Eleven Member States implemented some or all of the 13 measures in 2001, but Greece, Ireland, Luxembourg and Portugal did not implement any of Article 33. In total, 34 995 applications were approved under Article 33 in 2001. The total public expenditure committed was €1 433 million, of which €652 million (46%) was from the EAGGF.

Of the Article 33 measures, the most widely implemented in 2001 were (u) protection of the environment (10 Member States, 41 of 87 programmes), and (p) diversification (10 Member States, 40 of 87 programmes). In terms of public expenditure, the picture was different, with (k) reparaCelling and (o) renovation / protection being the most significant measures. By both criteria, the least implemented measure was (v) financial engineering (4 Member States, 4 of 87 programmes).

For most of these measures, there is considerable variation in the average public expenditure per application. For example, the average public expenditure on (m) marketing of quality agricultural products varied between €1 085 in Germany and €149 667 in Belgium, while, for (k) reparaCelling, the average public expenditure per hectare in the Netherlands was over 10 times higher than that in any other Member State.

J. LAND IMPROVEMENT – Table 19

98 applications were approved to support land improvement in 2001, covering 160 012 ha and a public expenditure commitment of €9.13 million (of which €3.43 million (38%) was from the EAGGF). In terms of public expenditure, this was the second least popular Article 33 measure after financial engineering.

K. REPARCELLING (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 20

8 236 applications were approved for reparaCelling in 2001, with a public expenditure commitment of €290 million (of which €225 (78%) was from the EAGGF). Of the 1.67 million ha covered by these applications, over 90 per cent were in Germany. Over 60 per cent of the expenditure committed was also in Germany, although there was also significant expenditure in the Netherlands, despite a relatively small number of hectares covered.

L. SETTING-UP OF FARM RELIEF AND FARM MANAGEMENT SERVICES (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 21

132 applications for the setting-up of farm relief services, and 462 for farm management services, were approved in 2001. The total public expenditure committed was €15.6 million (of which €6.14 million (39%) was from the EAGGF).

M. MARKETING OF QUALITY AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 22

1 590 applications for support for marketing of quality agricultural products were approved in 2001, of which over half were from France. The total public expenditure committed was €39.4 million (of which €19.1 million (49%) was from the EAGGF).

N. BASIC SERVICES FOR THE RURAL ECONOMY AND POPULATION (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 23

2 727 applications for support for basic services for the rural economy and population were approved in 2001, with a total public expenditure commitment of €63.5 million (of which €26.4 million (42%) was from the EAGGF).

O. RENOVATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF VILLAGES AND PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION OF THE RURAL HERITAGE (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 24

9 655 applications were approved for this measure, of which 88 per cent were for the renovation and development of villages and the remainder were for the protection and conservation of rural heritage. The public expenditure commitment was €231 million (of which €69.3 million (30%) was from the EAGGF). Over four-fifths of the applications approved and three-quarters of the expenditure committed were in Germany.

P. DIVERSIFICATION OF AGRICULTURAL ACTIVITIES AND ACTIVITIES CLOSE TO AGRICULTURE TO PROVIDE MULTIPLE ACTIVITIES OR ALTERNATIVE INCOME (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 25

5 556 applications were approved for this measure, of which 30 per cent were related to agri-tourism. The public expenditure commitment was €107 million (of which €41.3 million (39%) was from the EAGGF). Two-thirds of the approved applications were French.

Q. AGRICULTURAL WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 26

607 applications were approved for this measure, of which 73 per cent were related to irrigation. The average size of the applications was relatively large, leading to a total public expenditure commitment of €67 million (of which €6.1 million (40%) was from the EAGGF). Over 60 per cent of the applications and nearly half the public expenditure committed were Spanish.

R. DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF INFRASTRUCTURE CONNECTED WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF AGRICULTURE (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 27

2 445 applications were approved for this measure in 2001, with a total public expenditure commitment of €63 million (of which €73.3 million (45%) was from the EAGGF).

S. ENCOURAGEMENT FOR TOURIST AND CRAFT ACTIVITIES (CH. IX, Art. 33) – (Table 28)

9 655 applications for support for encouragement for tourist and craft activities were approved in 2001. 94 per cent of these related to tourism. The total public expenditure committed was €2.2 million (€23.0 million (44%) of which was from the EAGGF).

T. PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT IN CONNECTION WITH AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY AND LANDSCAPE CONSERVATION AS WELL AS THE IMPROVEMENT OF ANIMAL WELFARE (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 29

2 646 applications were approved for this measure. 95 per cent of the applications were for environmental protection, but the number of hectares these covered cannot be reliably estimated due to a low response for this indicator. The remaining 5 per cent of applications were for the improvement of animal welfare. The total public expenditure committed was €18 million (€50.6 million (43%) of which was from the EAGGF).

U. RESTORING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION POTENTIAL DAMAGED BY NATURAL DISASTERS AND INTRODUCING APPROPRIATE PREVENTION INSTRUMENTS (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 30

3 264 applications were received for this measure, split roughly equally between restoring production potential and introducing prevention instruments. While over 90 per cent of the applications were from Italy or Spain, the relatively small number of applications for Germany (196) involved a much larger average cost, and thus the vast majority of the €177 million of public expenditure committed (€47.3 million (27%) of which was from the EAGGF) was from Germany.

V. FINANCIAL ENGINEERING (CH. IX, Art. 33) – Table 31

Only 11 applications were approved in 2001 for this measure, involving a public expenditure commitment of €1.41 million (€30 000 (38%) of which was from the EAGGF)

CONCLUSIONS

This report provides an overview, with both physical and financial data, of the early implementation in the European Union of rural development programmes for the 2000–2006 programming period.

The lack of data available in the correct format for 2000 and for the EAGGF-Guidance funded programmes means that the scope of the report is more restricted than might have been hoped. Furthermore, errors and omissions in the data used inevitably cast doubt on the strength of the conclusions that can be drawn from the report.

However, it must be acknowledged that 2001 was a year where some programmes were still being finalised, and Member States understandably tended to focus on ongoing commitments from the previous programming period. In addition, 2001 was the first year that national and regional administrations applied the new guidelines for rural development monitoring indicators, and perfecting reporting is inevitably a learning process that takes time.

Complete national or Community level aggregation of monitoring indicators, providing a comprehensive picture of rural development programming across the EU, is only possible when the full data-set is available. The extent to which future summary reports can cover the full Community rural development effort will depend on the ability of Member States to supply the full range of monitoring data in future years.
