COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION

on the definitive allocation of European Union aid to Member States under a School Fruit Scheme for the period from 1 August 2011 to 31 July 2012

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007 of 22 October 2007 establishing a common organisation of agricultural markets and on specific provisions for certain agricultural products¹, and in particular Article 103h(f) in conjunction with Article 4 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Pursuant to Article 15(1) of Commission Regulation (EC) No 288/2009 of 7 April 2009 laying down detailed rules for applying Council Regulation (EC) No 1234/2007 as regards Community aid for supplying fruit and vegetables, processed fruit and vegetables and banana products to children in educational establishments, in the framework of a School Fruit Scheme², Member States wishing to participate in the School Fruit Scheme for the period from 1 August 2011 to 31 July 2012 were required to notify their strategy by 31 January 2011 at the latest.
- (2) In order to maximise the potential of available funds, the aid earmarked for those Member States which did not notify the Commission of their intention to participate in the European Union School Fruit Scheme or which requested only part of their initial allocation should be reallocated among those Member States which notified the Commission of their intention to use more than their initial allocation of aid.
- (3) Denmark, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia and Slovakia notified the Commission of their intention to participate in the European Union School Fruit Scheme and also notified their intention to use more than their initial allocation. Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Austria and Poland also notified the Commission of their intention to participate in this scheme but did not request a higher amount than their initial allocation.
- (4) The measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for the Common Organisation of Agricultural Markets,

Article 1

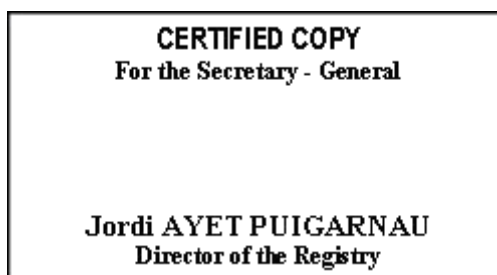
