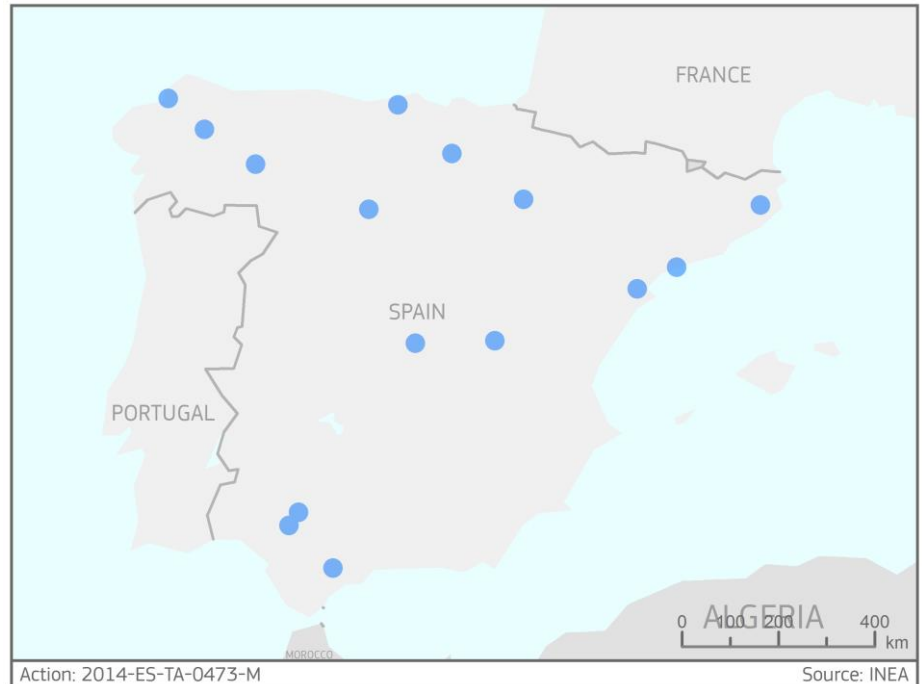

Improving access of rail infrastructure for people with disabilities and reduced mobility and the creation of intermodal transport chains are priorities of the Spanish transport sector.

The Action aimed to improve passengers' accessibility in the stations along the Comprehensive Railway Network in Spain. The Action was part of a Global Project to promote equal opportunities for disabled people and a better quality of life for all citizens in 229 Spanish stations.

Activities concerned studies, supplies and works on 15 selected Spanish stations. In the long term, the Action will allow an increase of passengers' traffic, enhancing their overall safety and security.
