This Action was the second stage of a Global Project aiming at fostering greater cross-border cooperation between Finland and Estonia through developing and upgrading the MoS link between the ports of Helsinki and Tallinn and thus connecting the North Sea-Baltic to the Scandinavian-Mediterranean Core Network Corridors. It follows the previous TEN-T funded Action TWIN-PORT (2012-EU-21011-P).

In the Port of Helsinki, a new fast-flow terminal of 13,800 m2 area with passenger skyways and passenger gangways was successfully constructed. The terminal included upper deck ramps to the berths LJ7 and LJ8. Gate operations with check-in automation and traffic connections to the terminal were improved.

In the Port of Tallinn, the Action included in particular the extension of terminal D as well as the reconstruction of access to terminal A. Moreover, a connection between these two terminals was built, a microtunnel in the Sadama street for sewage reception was built and finally a Hazard and Operability Analysis HAZOP study for the Old City Harbour was performed.

The capacity on the MoS link was also increased through the construction of a new generation LNG RoPax vessel. These investments significantly advanced the Global Project of removing port bottlenecks and optimising the port operations.
