The Action is a detailed study of the current gauge barriers/obstacles identified in the Spanish rail network that prevent the 'Rail Motorways' services from development along the Atlantic and Mediterranean Core Network Corridors. The study will focus on the singular elements of the lines that may interfere with the gauge such as tunnels, overpasses, platforms, catenary heights and other elements.

The Action is part of the Global project which aims to provide specific gauge studies that will allow improving and adapting the rail network to new freight services.
