

Crocodile 3 was the follow-up of the previous EU co-funded projects CROCODILE and CROCODILE II, in which Member States (5 in this case: AT, IT, SI, CY and CZ) worked together to improve cross-border road transport by implementing ITS (Intelligent Transport Systems) applications. The Action contributed to Commission Regulation 886/2013 regarding the free provision of road safety-related minimum universal traffic information to users, as well as Commission Regulation 885/2013 regarding information services for safe and secure parking places for trucks and commercial vehicles.

Some of the most remarkable outputs of the Action are the 14 cross-border Traffic Management Plans, and the implementation of 5 National Access Points (NAP).

4 DATEX nodes were improved, and several end-user applications have been implemented: a website and smartphone app in Austria, 1 website, 1 application, 3 information points and 1 call center in Italy. More than 2,500 km are covered by these new user information services.
