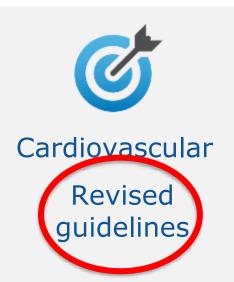

- Major initiatives or guidance European Child Guarantee, cancer screening recommendations, Europe Beating Cancer Plan, Year of Youth
- **Economies of scale** or common **scientific** evidence European Cancer Code, research agendas
