CEF eID helps you become eIDAS compliant:

Interoperability: Ensures that people and businesses can use their national eID schemes to access public services in other EU countries

Trust: Provides and ensures legal validity of transactions across borders and same legal status as traditional paper based processes

Security: Levels of Assurance (LoA) of eID schemes under eIDAS lower the risk of identity theft and misuse of personal information

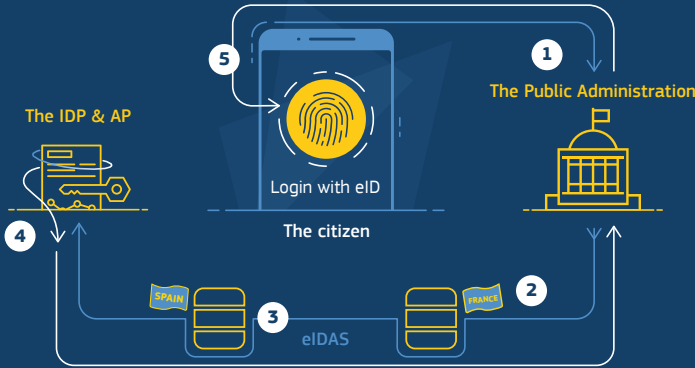

eID is available for public service providers...



- 1 A Spanish citizen, wants to register his new address in France and registers online.
- 2 To verify his/her identity, the public administration communicates with the national eIDAS node.
- 3 The eIDAS Node in France transmits the request to the eIDAS Node in Spain.
- 4 His/her identity is verified by the Spanish identity and attribute providers.
- 5 The verified request is sent back to the French public administration, allowing him/her to access the service.
