It is a non-partisan and non-governmental organization. The research activities (e.g. societal analysis) carried out by the GPA have strong policy-oriented and problem-solving approach, aiming to elaborate practical recommendations for particular policy problems and raise public debate by strong collaboration with politicians, medias, experts, social activists. The Institute comprises of four departments: the European Programme, the Social Policy Programme, the Migration and Eastern Policy Programme as well as the Law and Citizen Programme. This setup facilitates an interdisciplinary approach to all facets of European policy issues.
