

Is transmission and service of documents between Member States today faster than before the Regulation entered into force?



Which problems, if any, has the introduction of direct transmission of documents between local bodies caused?



Is the possibility to serve documents in a language other than the official language(s) of the Member State addressed used?



Which problems, if any, has the application of Article 8 caused?



Which problems, if any, has the application of Article 9 caused?





Are documents frequently served directly by post?



Which problems concerning postal service have you encountered or are you aware of?




