On 21 October 2019 Confindustria organized a workshop in Rome on the new EU Innovation Fund, with the participation of DG Climate Action - European Commission, the Ministries of Environment, Economic Development and Research & Innovation and more than 40 participants from both Confindustria member associations and companies.

- Introductory remarks by Nicoletta Amodio, Head of Research & Innovation, Confindustria

Nicoletta Amodio, Confindustria Head of Research & Innovation, dealt with the introductory remarks, presenting the scope of the workshop, the work carried on by Confindustria on the main EU research & innovation instruments and introduced the institutional guests.

- Presentation by Christian Holzleitner, Head of Unit Land Use and Finance for Innovation, DG Climate Action, European Commission

Christian Holzleitner from DG Clima explained the ratio behind the new EU Innovation Fund, which will replace the old NER300, and its functioning.

First reactions from national institutions

Mauro Maurici, from the Ministry of Environment, the Land and the Sea explained the position of Italy vis-à-vis the negotiation taking place in Brussels with regards to the governance of the Fund. Riccardo Basosi, Italian Permanent Representative in Energy Committee of HORIZON 2020 and Ministry of Research & Innovation Delegate for the SET (Strategic Energy Technology) Plan and Mission Innovation Program Inter-Ministry Task-Force, explained the interactions with the other R&I tools, especially in the field of energy.

Marcello Capra, from the Ministry of Economic Development, highlighted the main competitiveness issues.

Participants had the chance to ask the Commission for more details regarding the application procedures, the timelines and providing concrete examples of projects to be financed.
