



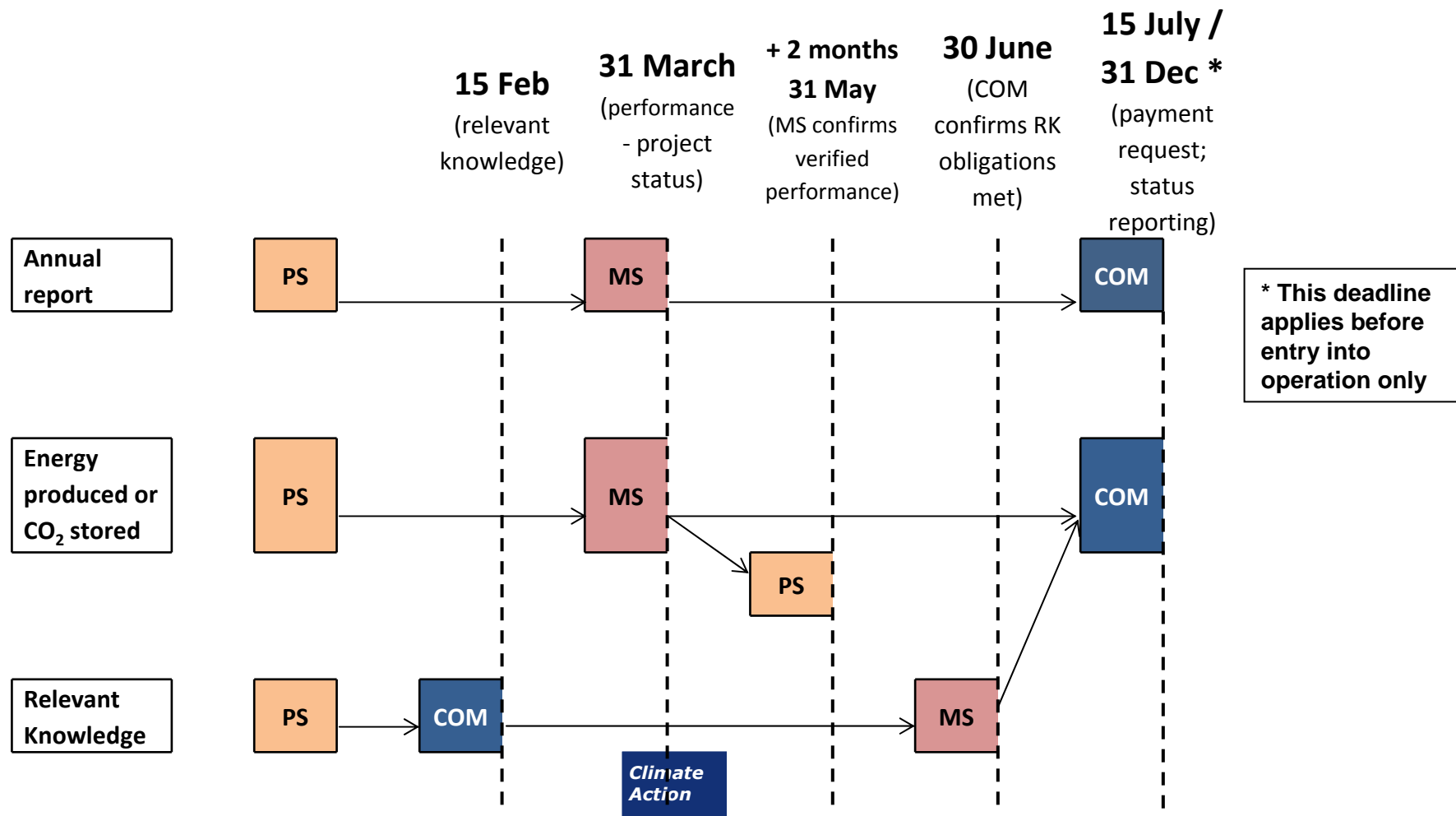

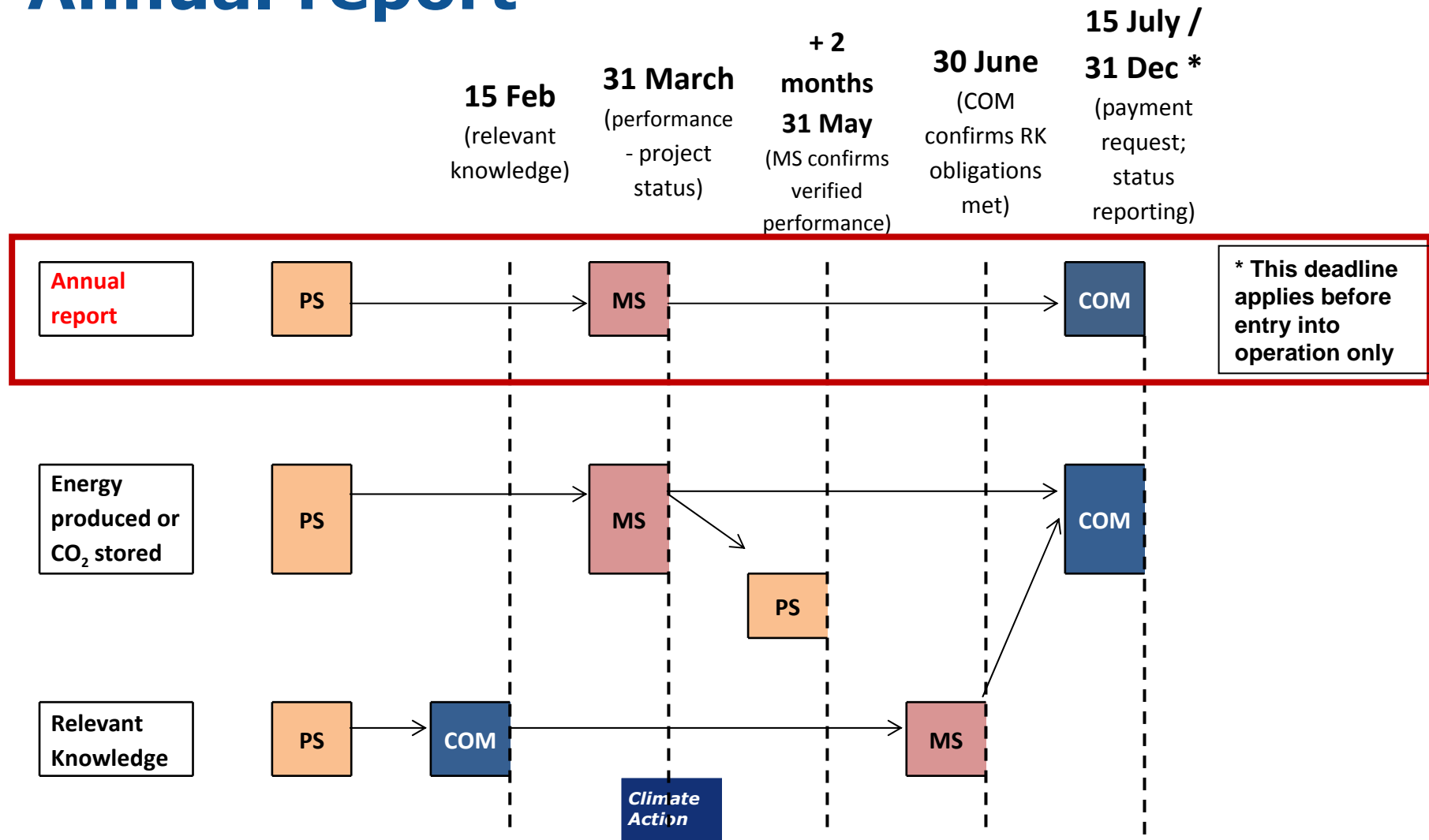

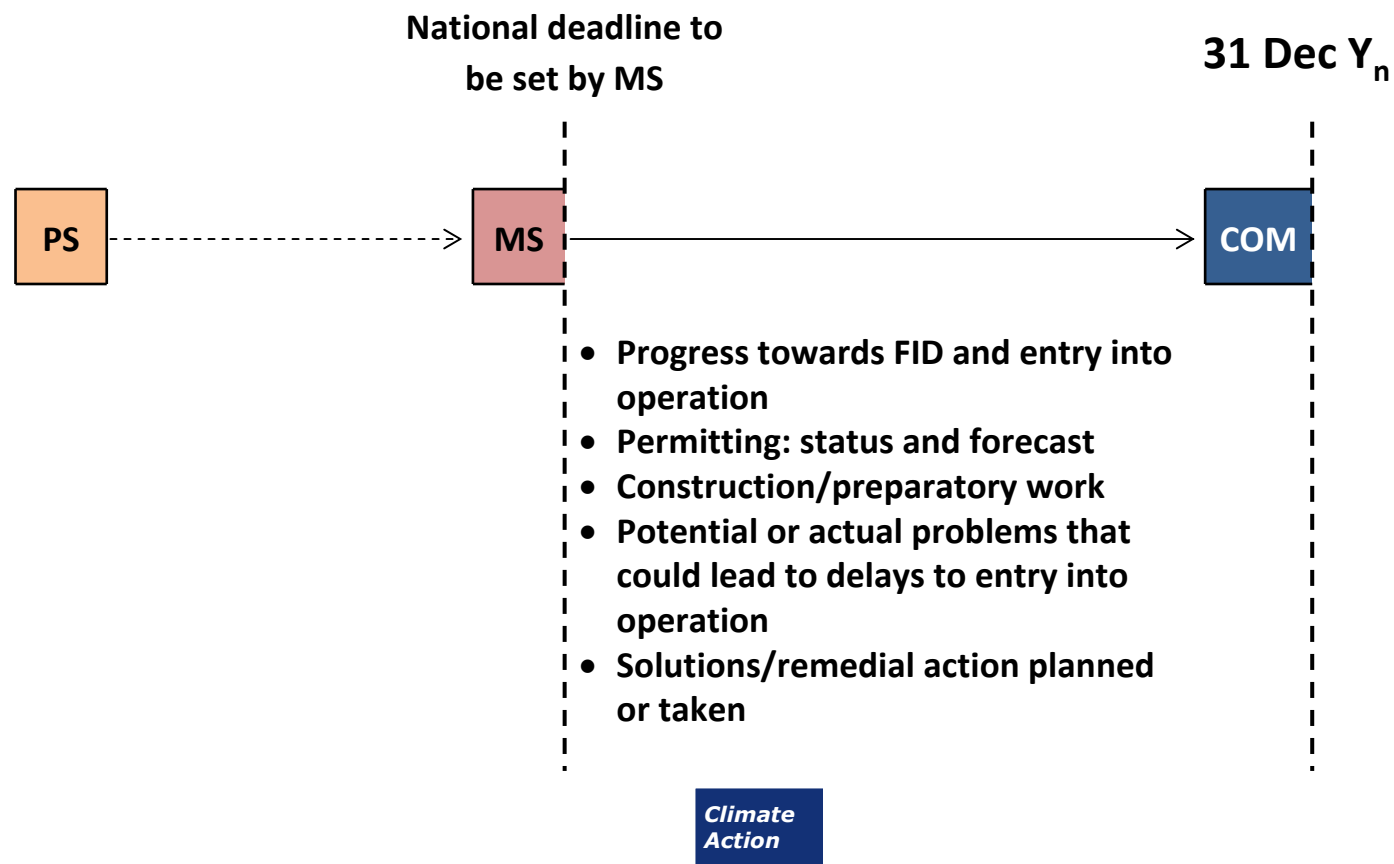


Annual report

- Award Decision: Condition 9 (Annex 2) and Annex III of the Specifications for Legally Binding Instrument (SLBI - Annex 3)
- 2 Regimes:
 - a) From award to entry into operation**
 - b) From entry into operation to long-stop date (year of entry into operation + 5 years for RES projects or 10 for CCS project)**
- Purpose:
 - **Monitor progress towards FID, entry into operation (permitting, state aid)**
 - **Ensure project implemented as per specifications in application**

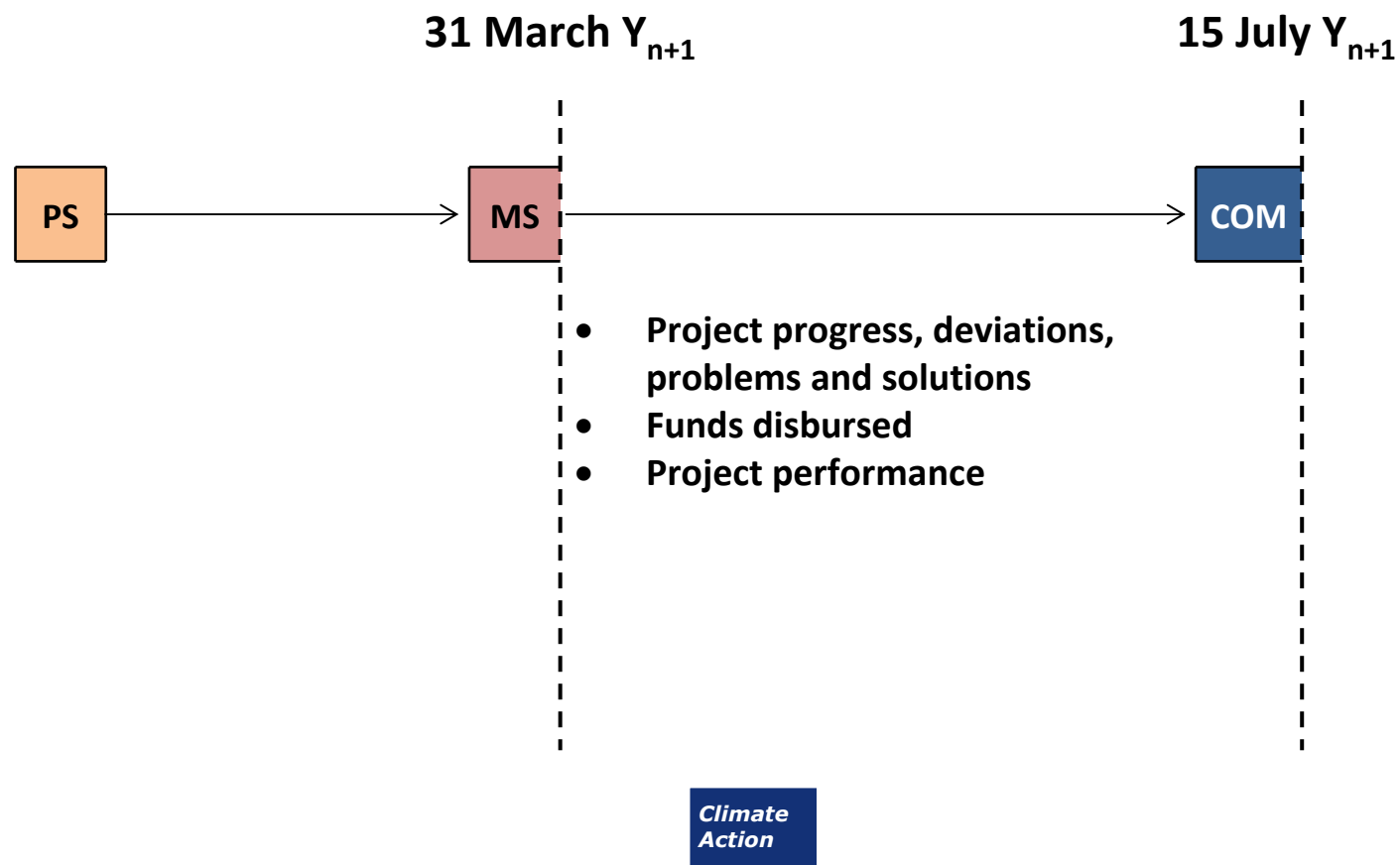

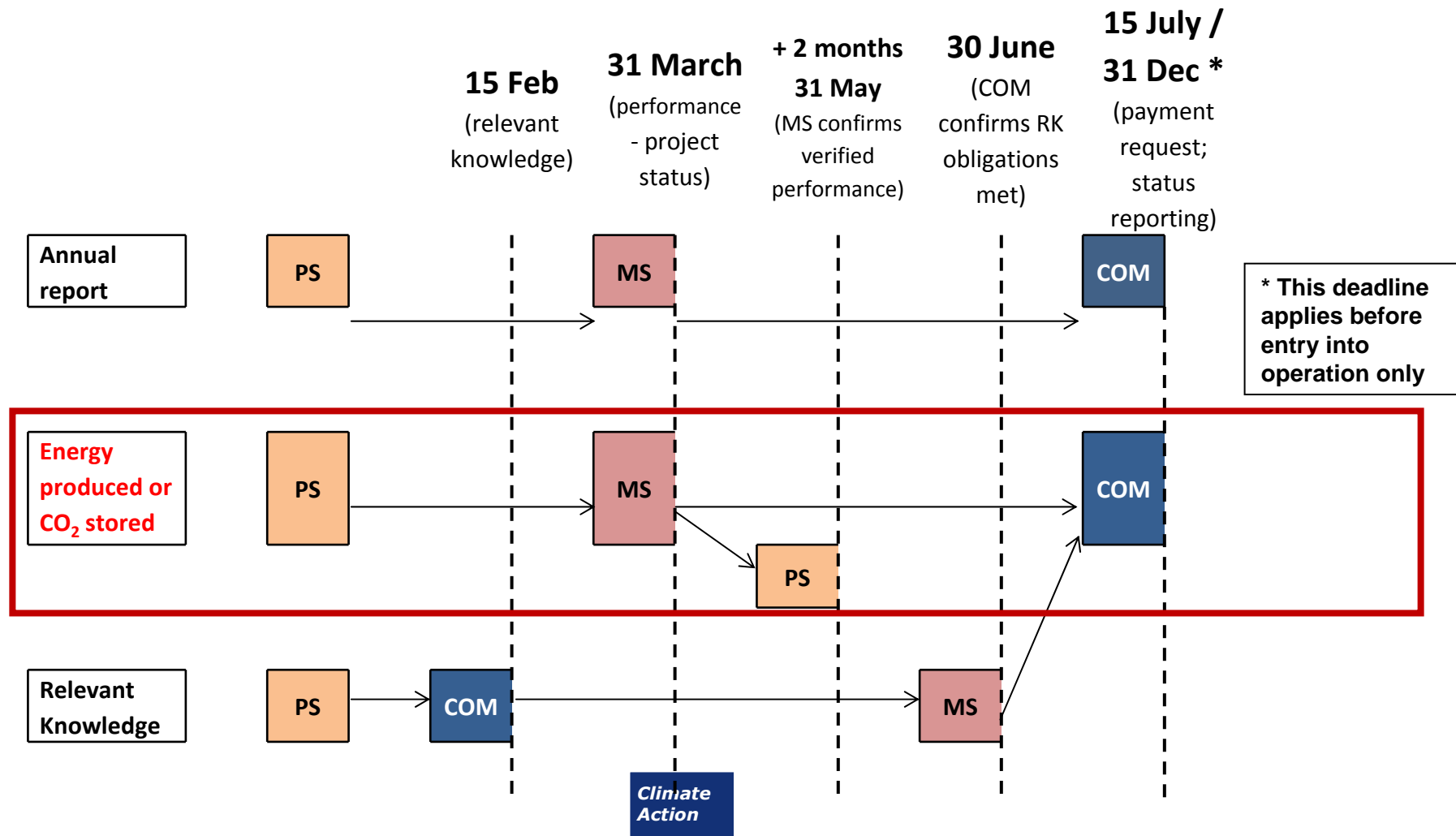

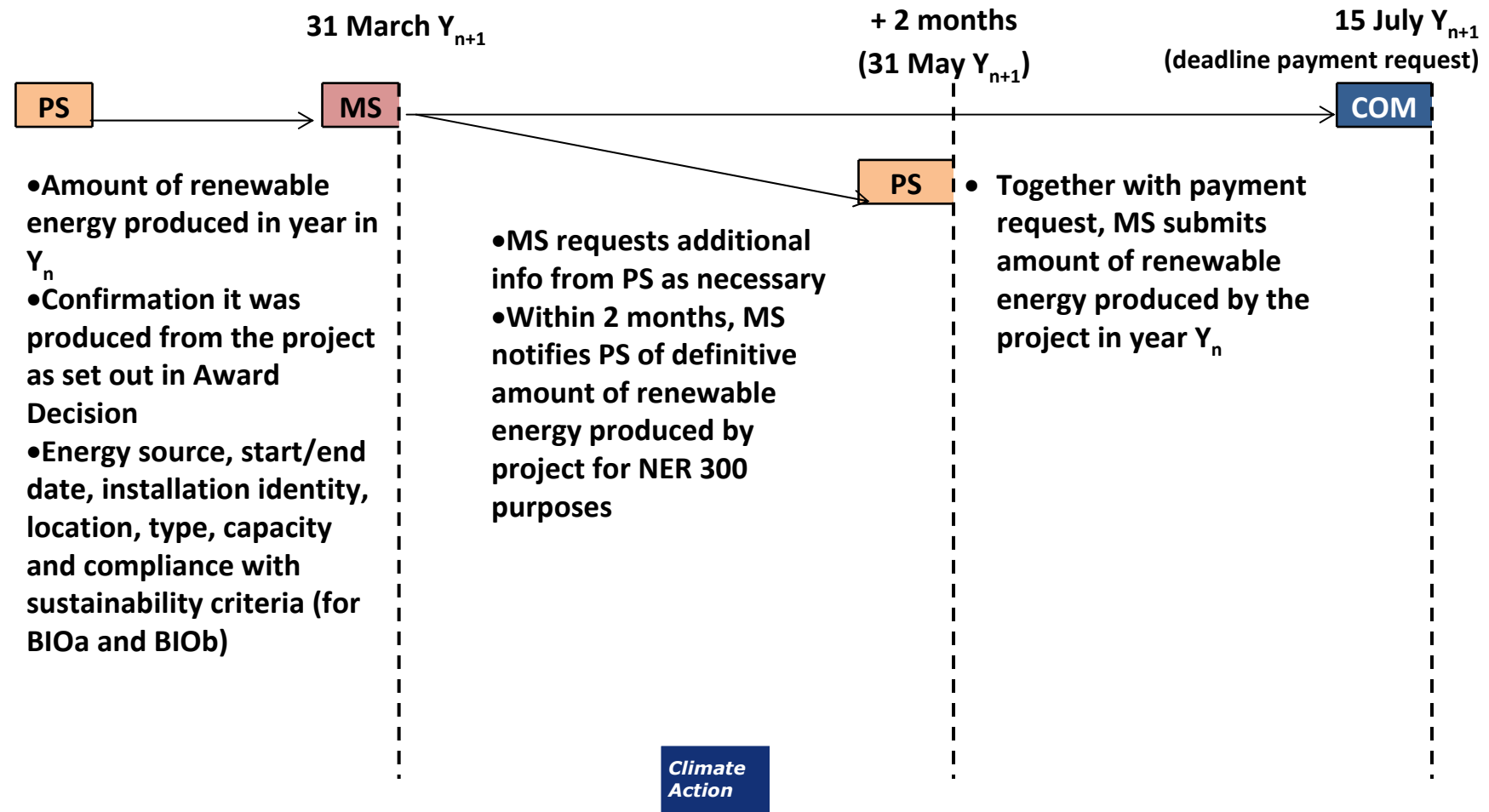




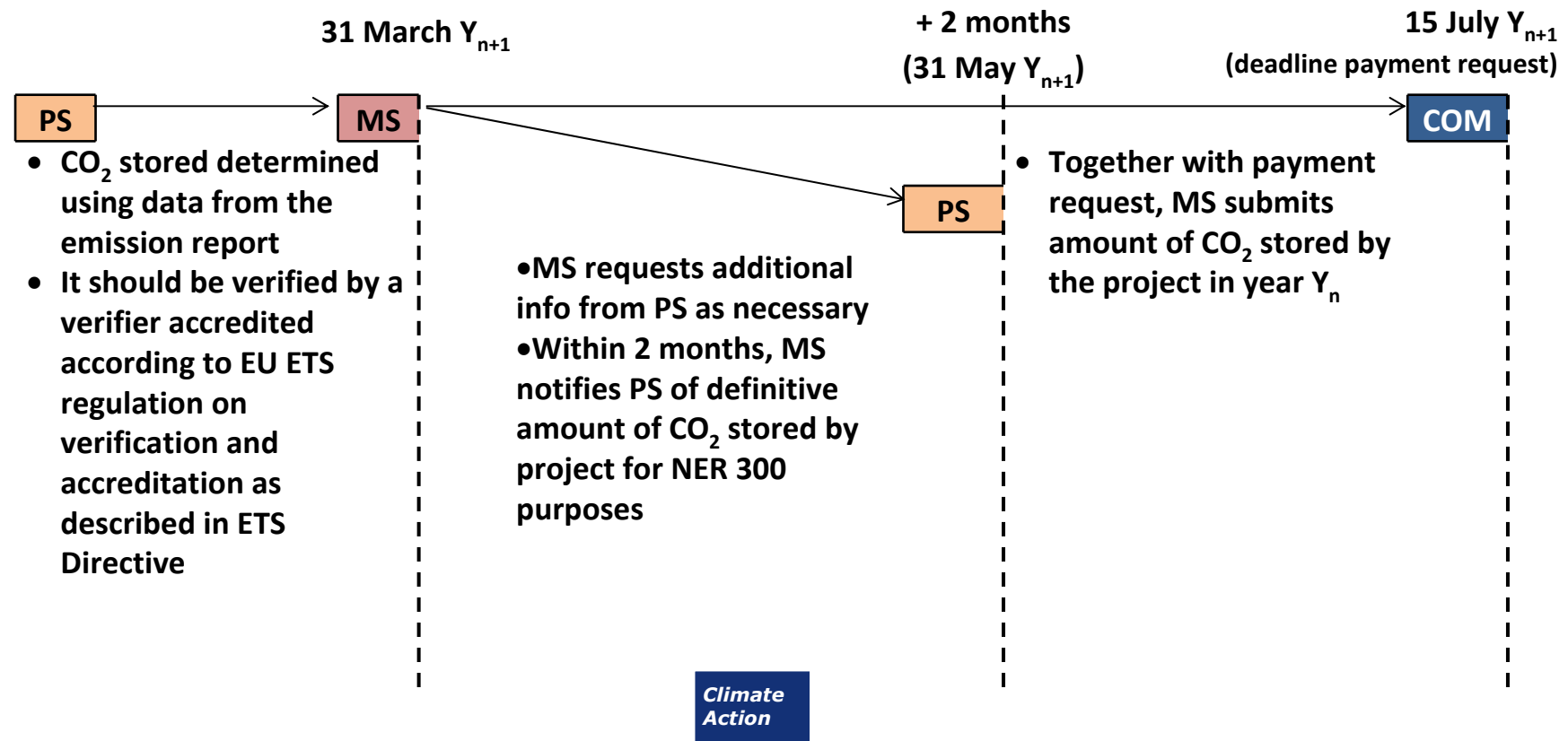
Performance

- After entry into operation only
- SLBI - Annex III (1.d, 2.c and 3.f)
- Different reporting requirements for:
 - a) **RES**
 - b) **CCS**
- Purpose:
 - **To show energy was produced by projects in accordance with RES Directive 2009/28/EC (for RES projects) or CO₂ stored was monitored in line with ETS Directive 2003/87/EC (for CCS project)**
 - **To establish the level of funding to be disbursed**

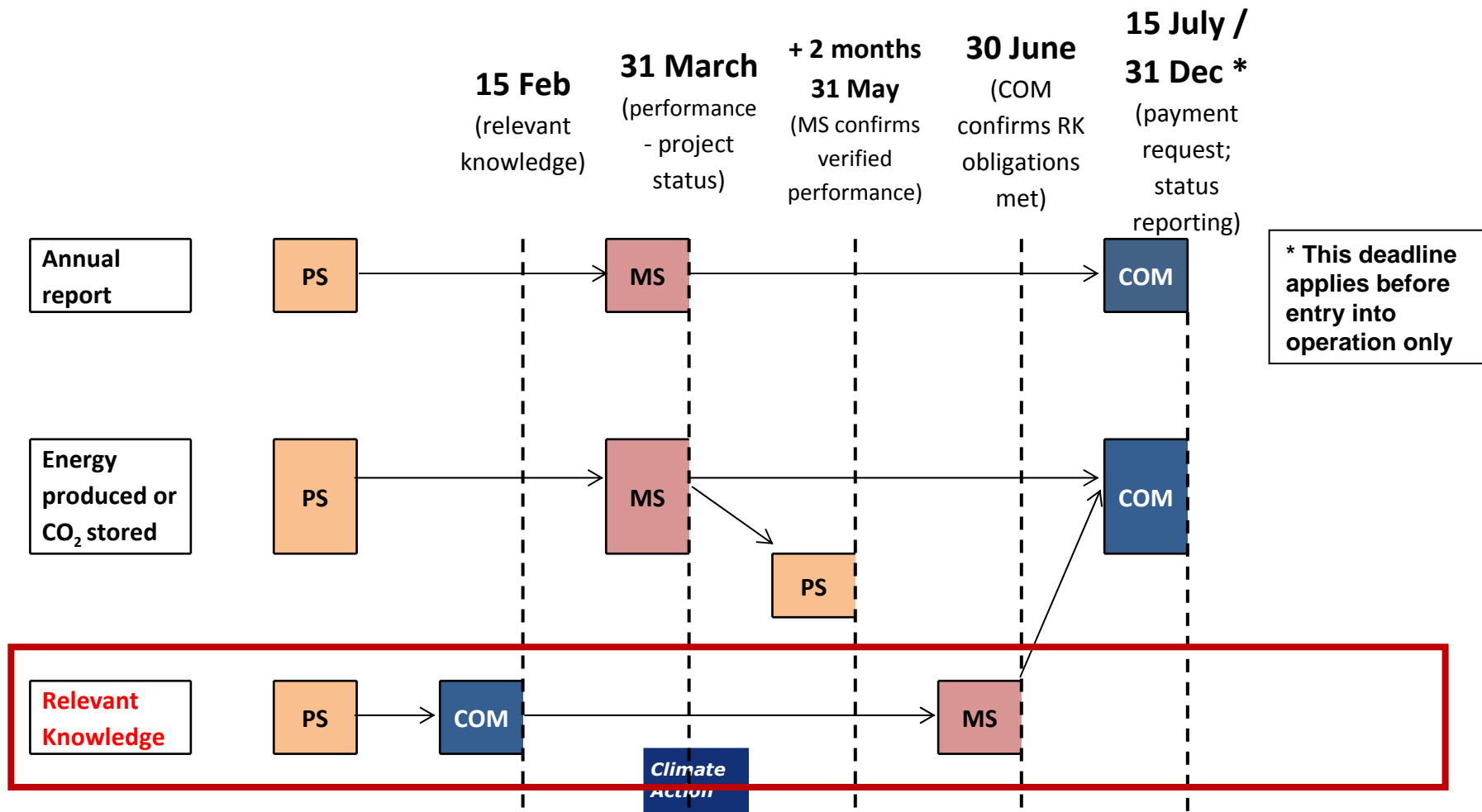
Energy produced (performance – for RES)



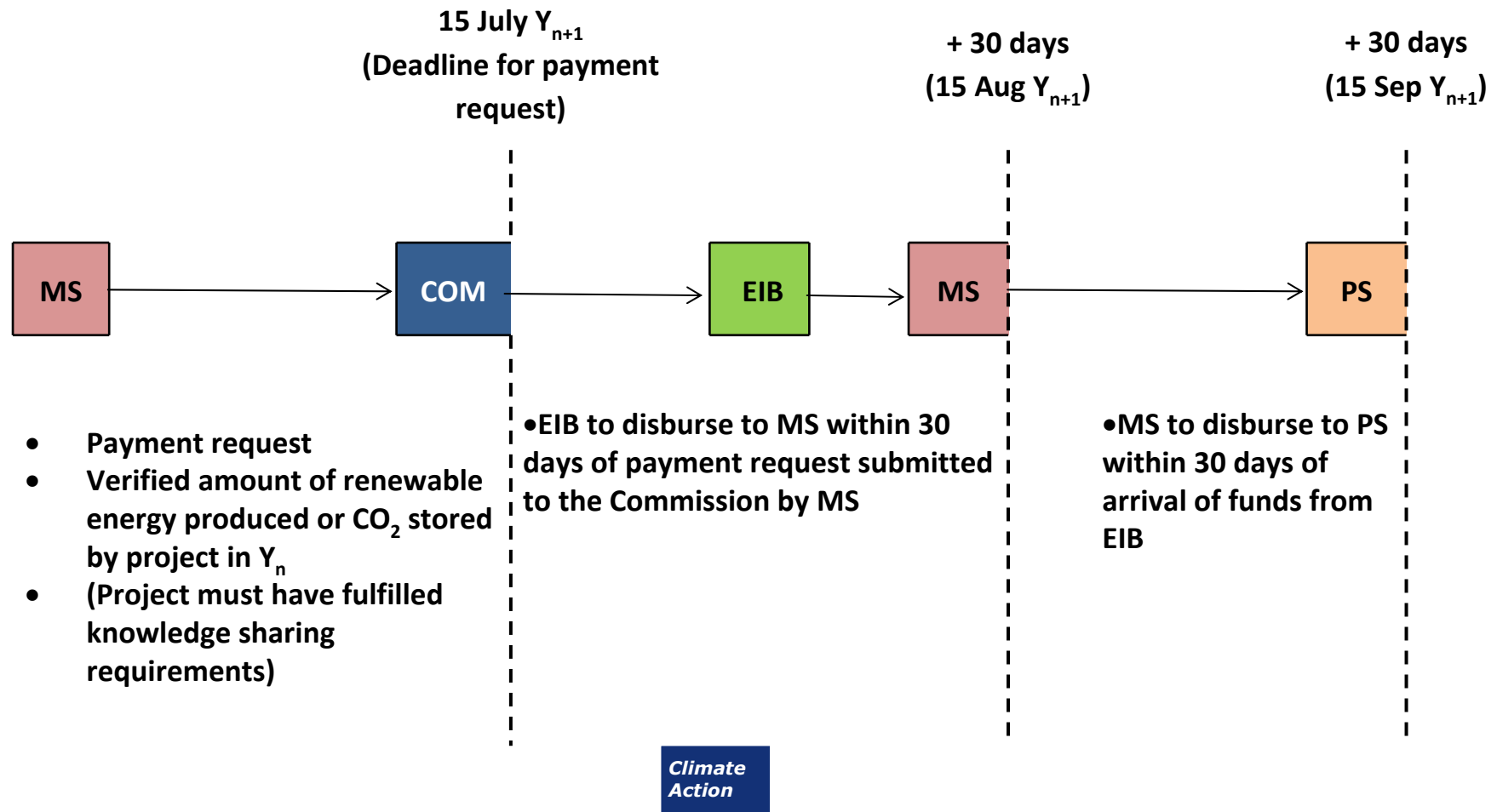
CO₂ stored (performance – for CCS)
