

THE CHARTER OF FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS OF THE EUROPEAN UNION

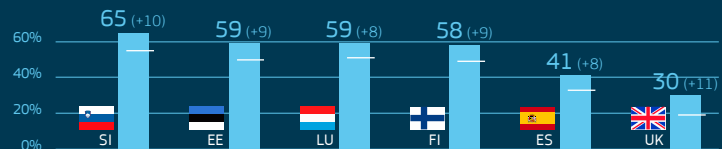


Though the situation has slightly improved since 2012,

only **42%** (+3 pp) of Europeans **have heard** of the Charter

and **12%** (+5 pp) **really know what it is**

Have heard of the Charter
Highest increases



Only **16%** (+2 pp) **feel informed** about the Charter

72% (=)
Total 'Not informed'

Unsurprisingly there is a **strong interest** in having more information about:

60% **Where to turn** if their rights, as enshrined in the Charter, are violated

60% **The content** of the Charter

59% **When the Charter applies** and when it does not

When their rights have been violated, **European citizens will turn to:**
