The Panel submitted its recommendations (<http://bit.ly/29z7V3l>) to the UN Secretary General helping frame the discussion at the World Humanitarian Summit in May 2016 and its aftermath, as well as facilitating their implementation. Co-chairing of the Panel is limited in duration and non-remunerated.


