

Emergency EU support available for migration and border management

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1 Border management

FRONTEX DEPLOYMENTS

- 24/7 Situation and crisis monitoring services, real-time operational information exchange
- Deployment of standing corps
- 111 Frontex border guards deployed to date to Lithuania and Latvia to address the Belarus crisis
- Additional **€200 million** made available by the Commission for border management in Latvia, Lithuania and Poland

► FUNDING



Under the Border Management & Visa Instrument (BMVI), **€6.4 billion** available over 2021-2027 for integrated border management



€3.7 billion allocation to Member States foreseen; a further **€2.7 billion** to be flexibly used for EU-wide priorities, including emergency assistance

2 Migration management

SUPPORT FROM THE EUROPEAN ASYLUM SUPPORT OFFICE (EASO)

- For handling of asylum applications and improving reception conditions
- For capacity building and for monitoring asylum trends and secondary movements
- 73 EASO experts deployed to date to Lithuania



RECEPTION CONDITIONS AND ASYLUM PROCEDURES

- The Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) can be used to fund infrastructure for the reception of non-EU nationals
- Under the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund **€9.9 billion** is available over 2021-2027 for effective migration management
- Additional EU funding of up to **€30 million** in the form of an emergency grant is available to cover reception support

► SUPPORT ON RETURNS

Operational support by Frontex including organisation of flights, outreach to third countries, deployment of return specialists

3 Security aspects

EUROPOL SUPPORT

- Europol's European **Migrant Smuggling Centre** supports criminal investigations and facilitates information exchanges through its Joint Liaison Task Force Migrant Smuggling and Trafficking in Human Beings
- Europol's **Internet Referral Unit** provides open source monitoring and supports Member States in combating migrant smuggling and related crimes using the internet

4 Commission coordination, guidance and outreach

- The EU Migration Preparedness and Crisis Management Network (the Blueprint Network) coordinates EU actions, monitoring progress and needs
- Commission visits on the ground, legal and operational advice and cooperation with UNHCR, IOM and NGOs
- EU outreach to third countries
