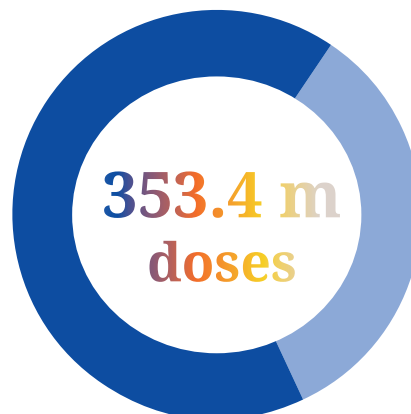

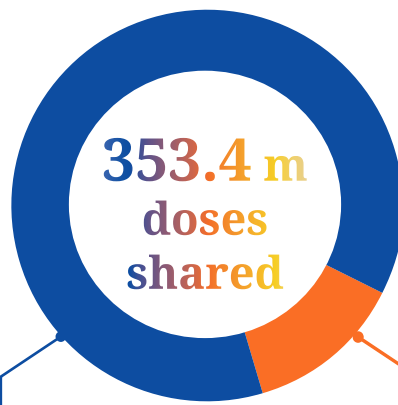

## Financial support by Team Europe



Team Europe mobilised **€46 billion for the global response** to COVID19, of which **€9.8 billion for Africa** to address the health emergency, strengthen key health, water and sanitation systems, and offer socioeconomic support



Team Europe is lead contributor with over **€3 billion** for the COVAX Facility to help secure access to **fully donor-funded doses for 92 lower-income economies**.



The **European Commission has also worked with industrial partners**, which are manufacturing vaccines in Europe, to quickly make available vaccine doses for low and middle-income countries.



At the Global Health Summit, our industrial partners committed to make **1.5 billion doses of vaccines available to low-income countries at no profit**, and to middle-income countries at lower prices by the end of 2021, many of which will go via COVAX. They have also committed 1.5 billion doses for 2022.



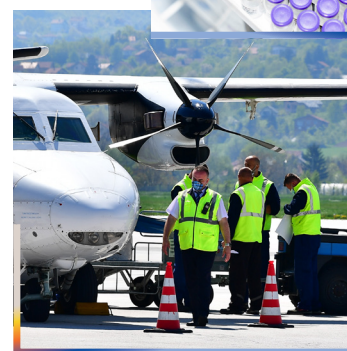
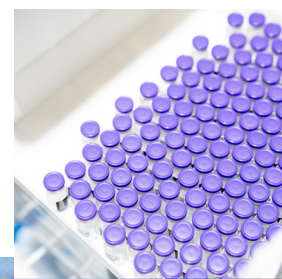
Team Europe is investing **€1 billion to ramp up health technologies and mRNA and medicine production** capacities in Africa.

# COVID-19 vaccine exports from the EU to the rest of the world

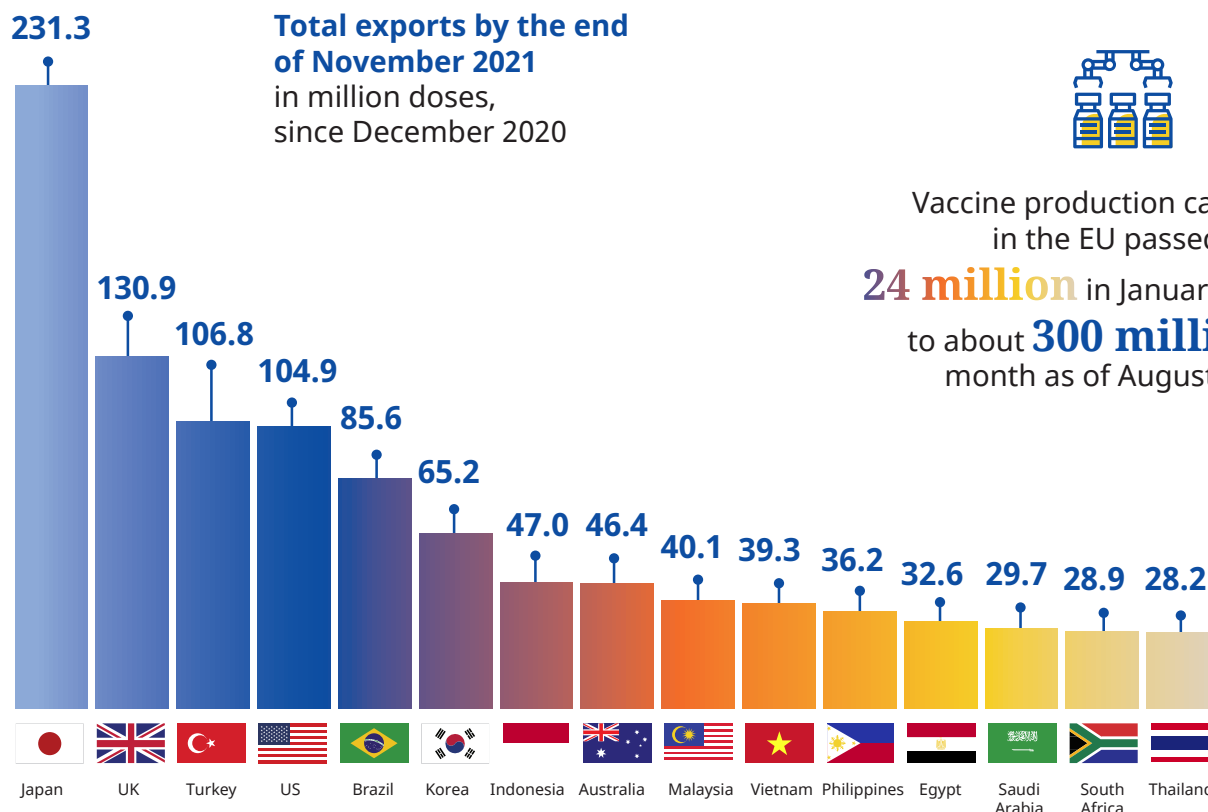
Over **1.4 billion doses** to more than **150 countries**.

## Top 15 export destinations



Vaccine production capacity in the EU passed from **24 million** in January 2021 to about **300 million** a month as of August 2021.

## Team Europe's humanitarian support to vaccination



Team Europe's humanitarian effort amounts to **€655 million**, of which **€203 million** in 2021.

### Examples

- supporting COVID-19 vaccination rollout in 34 African countries
- identification of vulnerable refugees in East Africa (eg in Ethiopia, Kenya, Rwanda, Tanzania and Uganda) who should be prioritised for vaccine intake, with community engagement and awareness raising

Union civil protection mechanism delivered **26 million doses to 37 countries**, and a **further 8 million** are on the way.

**Example:** donation of over 433 000 doses from Denmark, Croatia and Bulgaria to secure a second round of vaccination to the whole population of Bhutan.



With **\$25 million**, Team Europe **is leading donor of Humanitarian Buffer under COVAX** (funding those excluded from the national vaccination plans, e.g. people living in conflict areas, areas controlled by non-state armed groups, IDPs and refugees)

### Examples

- Mid-november first delivery of 1.6 million doses to Iran to cover Afghan refugees.
- Next delivery of 720 000 doses to Thailand in December to vaccinate Rohingya.
