AWARD DECISION

Grant award procedure: Training of national judges in EU Competition Law– Call for proposals 2016

HAVING REGARD to Articles 133 (2) of Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 25 October 2012 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union (hereafter referred to as “the Financial Regulation”),

HAVING REGARD to Article 204 (5) of Commission Delegated Regulation No 1268/2012 of 29 October 2012 on the rules of application of Regulation 966/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union (hereafter referred to as “the Rules of Application”),

WHEREAS:

An Evaluation Committee was appointed pursuant to Article 204 (1) of the Rules of Application.

An evaluation was carried out pursuant to Articles 133 (1) and (2) of the Financial Regulation and 204 (1) of the Rules of Application.

I HEREBY DECIDE:

1. To award a maximum amount of EUR 866,187.84 for grants under the above mentioned call for proposals.
2. To award grants to the applicants listed in Annex 1.
3. Not to award grants to the applicants listed in Annex 2.
