On 25 April 2006, the Commission received the notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 (the Merger Regulation) by which The Boeing Company (United States of America) will acquire sole control over Carmen Systems AB (Sweden) ("Carmen Systems") by way of share purchase.

The business activities of the undertakings concerned are as follows:

Boeing: commercial aircraft, defence and space industries and related services. Boeing's Jeppesen business is active in the provision of a variety of services to airlines, including crew management services and fleet planning and scheduling services.

Carmen Systems: the provision of crew management services and fleet planning and scheduling services to airlines and other industries and the provision of disruption recovery services to airlines.
