SECTION 1.2

Description of the concentration

- 1. On 11 February 2009, the Commission received a notification of a concentration whereby EDF and EnBW acquire joint control of Kogeneracja directly or through affiliates.
- 2. EDF and EnBW are both active in the energy sector across Europe. EDF is based in Paris and EnBW is based in Germany.
- 3. Kogeneracja is also active in the electricity and heat sectors but its activities are limited exclusively to Poland.
- 4. The effects of the Transaction are limited to Poland. The increase in the Parties' aggregate market share, if any, is incremental. Their combined market share remains below 15% in each market concerned by the Transaction. There are no reportable markets.
- 5. The Transaction qualifies for treatment under the Simplified Procedure pursuant to point 1.1 of Annex II to the Implementing Regulation¹.
