## **SECTION 1.2**

## **Description of the concentration**

- 1. On 23 June 2011, the European Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004<sup>1</sup>. The proposed concentration concerns the acquisition within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of joint control over MIG Business Development A/S (to be renamed Universal Foundation, pursuant to the transaction, Denmark) by FOEW (part of the Fred. Olsen Energy group with as ultimate parent Bonheur ASA) ('Bonheur', Norway), DONG Energy Power (a wholly-owned subsidiary of DONG Energy A/S)('DONG', Denmark), Novasion (Denmark), and Aalborg Universitet (Denmark) by way of purchase of shares and contract.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
  - for MIG Business Development: sales, development and design of foundations for offshore wind turbines and met masts.
  - for Bonheur: shipping and offshore oil and gas exploitation.
  - for DONG: exploration, production, generation, trading, sales and distribution of energy
  - for Novasion: a holding company, holding a minority share in MIG Business Development
  - for Aalborg Universitet: Education and research
