## SECTION 1.2

## **Description of the concentration**

- 1. The notified transaction is the acquisition of joint control in the meaning of the EUMR by APM Terminals B.V. ("APMT") and Bolloré Africa Logistics, *via* SFAC, a 100% subsidiary of Bolloré Africa Logistics over a joint venture, Congo Terminal S.A. ("CT"). The Bolloré Group, through CT, has been granted a concession by the Port Autonome de Pointe Noire in Congo-Brazzaville to develop, manage and operate a container terminal and provide services to common users at the Port of Pointe Noire, Congo-Brazzaville.
- 2. APMT is a wholly-owned subsidiary of A.P. Møller-Maersk A/S. Bolloré Africa Logistics is a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Bolloré group, which is controlled by the holding company Financière de l'Odet, which is itself controlled by the Bolloré family.
- 3. The transaction is notified under the simplified procedure and the notifying parties consider it does not give rise to any competition concerns.
