SECTION 1.2

Description of the concentration

Mitsubishi Corporation and Mitsubishi Electric Corporation intend to acquire joint control over Melco de Colombia Ltda. The proposed transaction constitutes a concentration within the meaning of Article 3 (4) & (1)(b) of the EC Merger Regulation.

Mitsubishi Corporation is Japan's largest general trading company ($s\bar{o}g\bar{o}$ $sh\bar{o}sha$) with over 200 bases of operations in approximately 80 countries worldwide. MC has long been engaged in business with customers around the world in virtually every industry, including energy, metals, machinery, chemicals, food and general merchandise.
