Description of the concentration

Koch Industries, Inc., United States (*KII*), proposes to acquire indirectly all of the outstanding shares of Molex Incorporated, United States (*Molex*).

KII is a privately held U.S. corporation which, through a portfolio of controlled entities, supplies fuels for transportation, energy to heat and cool buildings, fibers for high-quality carpets and garments, water filtration and pollution control equipment, fertilizer, consumer products, building materials, and related products.

Molex designs, manufactures and sells electronic components, including terminals, connectors, cable assemblies, interconnection systems, sockets, antennas, integrated products and switches for use by original equipment manufacturers throughout the world.
