Description of the concentration

The proposed Transaction consists in the combination of Univeg Holding BV(*Univeg*), Peatinvest NV (*Peatinvest*) and Greenyard Foods NV (*Greenyard*) (together *the Businesses*). This will be realised through a contribution in kind by Univeg's and Peatinvest's shareholders of their shares in Univeg and Peatinvest to Greenyard. Greenyard would end up being the top company of the entire group, with Deprez Holding being the controlling shareholder after completion of the contributions.

Univeg is an international supplier of fresh produce, active in the areas of fruit and vegetables (including fresh-cut produce), flowers and plants, as well as, to a more limited extent, related transport and logistics. Univeg has operations in 27 countries, across the five continents. (www.univeg.com)

Greenyard is active in the processing and commercialisation of vegetables and fruit and ready-to-eat food, both deep-frozen and canned (under, respectively, the divisions Pinguin and Noliko).
