## **SECTION 1.2**

## **Description of the concentration**

On 22 June 2015 World Fuel Services Corporation (**WFS**) announced that through certain wholly owned subsidiaries it has entered into an agreement with BP to acquire the "**Divestment Business**" being divested by BP Plc (**BP**) pursuant to commitments submitted in Case M.7387 – *BP/Statoil Fuel and Retail Aviation*. As a result of the Proposed Transaction, WFS will acquire sole control over the Divestment Business within the meaning of Article 3(2) of Council Regulation 139/2004.

The Divestment Business includes all the elements of the former Statoil Fuel & Retail Aviation (SFRA) business at Copenhagen Kastrup, Stockholm Arlanda, Gothenburg Landvetter and Malmö airports.

WFS is a global provider of aviation, marine and ground transportation fuel products and related services. It is listed on the New York Stock Exchange and is present in more than 2,500 locations around the world.
