### **SECTION 1.2**

#### **Description of the concentration**

On 31 July 2015, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) 139/2004 by which 3i Infrastructure plc ("**3iN**") which is ultimately controlled by 3i Group plc ("**3i**") and funds ultimately controlled by AMP Capital Investors Limited ("**AMP**") would obtain joint control within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation of ESVAGT A/S and its subsidiaries.

The primary business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

- (a) **3i:** 3i is an international investor and investment management business focused on mid-market private equity, infrastructure and debt management. 3i's principal activities are originating and making investments using its own and third-party managed funds and subsequently managing those investments. 3i is headquartered in London and is listed on the London Stock Exchange. 3i invests in the infrastructure space primarily through 3iN, a company incorporated under the laws of Jersey and headquartered in Jersey, investing in infrastructure with a focus on the Utilities, Transportation and Social Infrastructure sectors. 3iN is listed on the London Stock Exchange.
- (b) **AMP:** AMP is a leading Australian investment house operating across a broad range of asset classes from fixed income and equities to direct investments and multi-manager funds. AMP has offices in Bahrain, China, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Luxembourg, the United Kingdom and the United States.
- (c) **ESVAGT A/S and its subsidiaries:** the provision of offshore emergency and rescue services at sea including the provision of standby / emergency response and rescue vessels as well as transfer of personnel for the provision of maintenance activities for offshore wind farms. As a part thereof, ESVAGT A/S and its subsidiaries also perform supplementary activities, including oil spill contingency services, tanker assistance, performance of rig moves and supply duties and inter-field transfer of cargo and personnel for offshore oil and gas rigs.
