SECTION 1.2

Description of the concentration

- (1) On 24 July 2017, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration under Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004, by which Singapore Airlines Engineering Company, a subsidiary of Singapore Airlines Limited, will create a joint venture with Moog Singapore Pte Ltd, itself a subsidiary of Moog Inc, to provide maintenance, repair and overhaul services (“MRO”) for Moog’s products on Boeing 787, Airbus A350 and other new generation aircraft.
- (2) The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - Singapore Airlines Limited: passenger and cargo transport, engineering services related to air transportation and airport terminal services; and
 - Moog Inc: development, manufacture and sale of precision motion control products and systems for the aerospace, defence, industrial, energy, marine and medical sectors.
- (3) The transaction concerns the aviation sector, and in particular MRO services of Moog Inc. flight controls for next generation aircraft.
