## **SECTION 1.2**

## **Description of the concentration**

On 22 July 2019, the European Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 3(4) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 involving the acquisition, by DENSO CORPORATION (**DENSO**) of sole control over the Hirose Plant.

The main business activities of the parties are as follows:

- DENSO is a Japanese manufacturer and supplier of advanced automotive parts and components for automobile manufacturers, non-automotive consumer products and industrial products, headquartered at 1-1, Showa-cho, Kariya, Aichi 448-8661, Japan.
- The Hirose Plant is a manufacturing facility (currently owned by the Toyota Motor Corporation), which is engaged in the production of semiconductors and electronic components for use in automobiles. The Hirose Plant is located at 543 Kirigabora, Nishihirose-cho, Toyota City, Aichi Prefecture, Japan.
