Description of the concentration

- 1. The notified concentration involves the proposed indirect acquisition of sole control of Corendon Holding B.V. ("Corendon", Netherlands) by the Triton group ("Triton", Luxembourg) by way of a purchase of shares, within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the EU Merger Regulation.
- 2. Triton is an investment firm headquartered in Northern Europe that invests primarily in medium-sized businesses, in particular in Austria, Germany, Switzerland and the five Nordic countries, with particular focus on businesses in three core sectors: Business Services, Industrials and Consumer/Health.
- 3. Sunweb is a European online tour operator, headquartered in Rotterdam. Sunweb offers package holidays from the Netherlands, Belgium, Denmark, United Kingdom, Sweden, Germany and France. Sunweb offers holidays predominantly to sunshine destinations and also supplies European ski holidays. Sunweb is indirectly solely controlled by Triton.
- 4. Corendon is a leisure services provider based in the Netherlands, founded in 2000. Corendon operates as a leisure tour operator, providing packaged holidays from Belgium and the Netherlands to over 40 sun and beach destinations, mostly in the Mediterranean but also to long-haul destinations. Corendon operates via its own website, its telephone contact centre and through third party channels (high street travel agencies and online). Corendon also operates a small airline.
