Description of the concentration

On 3 April 2020, the European Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 and Article 3(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 involving the establishment of a joint venture, to be jointly controlled by Saudi Aramco Development Company (**SADCO**), Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and Baker Hughes Company (**BHC**), United States.

- SADCO is a wholly owned subsidiary of Saudi Arabian Oil Company (**Saudi Aramco**) registered in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Saudi Aramco is primarily engaged in the exploration, production and marketing of crude oil and, to a lesser extent, in the production and marketing of refined products and petrochemicals.
- BHC is a global provider of integrated oilfield products, services, and digital solutions
 that enhance productivity, minimize risks and lower costs across the entire spectrum of
 oil and gas development.
- The newly to be created joint venture company will be established in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and will construct and operate manufacturing facilities for the production of nonmetallic/composite products for use in oil and gas applications.
