1. On **19.07.2010**, the European Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of the Merger Regulation by which the undertaking Nippon Telegraph and Telephone Corporation ('NTT', Japan) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Dimension Data Holdings Plc ('Dimension Data', South Africa) by way of public bid announced on 15 July 2010.

OJ L 24, 29.1.2004, p. 1 ("the Merger Regulation"). With effect from 1 December 2009, the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union ("TFEU") has introduced certain changes, such as the replacement of "Community" by "Union" and "common market" by "internal market". The terminology of the TFEU will be used throughout this decision.

- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - for NTT: IT services and global telecommunications services to customers outside Japan, and regional telecommunications services in Japan,
 - for Dimension Data: IT services.
- 3. After examination of the notification, the European Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of the Merger Regulation and of paragraph 5(c) of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004².
- 4. For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the European Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the internal market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation.
