- 1. On 9.10.2000, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 4064/89 by which the undertaking Kohlberg Kravis Roberts & Co., LP (KKR) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation, by way of purchase of shares and assets, control of the following businesses of the undertaking Laporte PLC (Laporte): pigments, additives, compounds, electronic chemicals and materials, timber treatment chemicals and water technologies.
- 2. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 4064/89 and of section II, paragraph 4, sub-paragraph c of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89<sup>2</sup>.
