On 6.04.2001, the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 4064/89 by which the undertaking Techint Compagnia Tecnica Internazionale spa ("Techint"), Italy, belonging to the Techint-Group, and VOEST-ALPINE Industrieanlagenbau GmbH ("VAI"), Austria, controlled by VA Technologie AG, acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation joint control of a newly created company by way of purchase of shares.

The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

- for Techint : design and supply of steel making equipment and related machinery
- for VAI : engineering and plant-building company

NewCo: design and construction of continuous casting equipment for billets and light blooms; design and construction of rolling mills for light long products and guides
