Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Grupo El Arbol Distribución y Supermercados, S.A.U. ("El Arbol", Spain), currently controlled by Laurus Luxembourg SQRL

- for El Arbol: retail sales of food and other non-specialised merchandise.
- 3. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 4064/89 and of
