Holdings Limited ("AHL", Australia) and by siblings Marlis and Hans-Heinrich Kieft, acquire joint control within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation of the whole of Neue Filmpalast GmbH & Co. ("Neue Filmpalast", Germany) by way of purchase of shares.

- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are :
 - Onex : acquiring, administrating and divesting participations in undertakings,
 - K&K: operating movie theatres in Germany,
 - Neue Filmpalast: operating movie theatres in Germany.
- 3. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 4064/89 and of paragraph 4, subparagraphs a, b, of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89².
- 4. For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the common market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EEC) No. 4064/89.
