- 1. On 30/07/2004, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 by which the undertakings Citicorp Venture Capital ("CVC", USA), controlled by Citigroup, Inc., and Francisco Partners ("FP", USA) acquire within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation joint control of the System IC Business of Hynix Semiconductor, Inc. of South Korea by way of purchase of shares.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - for undertaking CVC: venture capital fund;
 - for undertaking Citigroup: financial services;
 - for undertaking FP: venture capital fund;
 - for undertaking System IC Business: non-memory semiconductors
- 3. After examination of the notification, the Commission has concluded that the notified operation falls within the scope of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 and of

- paragraph 5(a) and 5(b) of the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under Council Regulation (EEC) No 139/2004².
- 4. For the reasons set out in the Notice on a simplified procedure, the Commission has decided not to oppose the notified operation and to declare it compatible with the common market and with the EEA Agreement. This decision is adopted in application of Article 6(1)(b) of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004.
