On 09.10.2006 the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No. 139/2004 by which the undertaking Permira Holdings Ltd ("PHL", Guernsey) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking BorsodChem Nyrt ("BorsodChem", Hungary) by way of purchase of shares.

The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:

- for Permira Holdings Ltd: Holding company for undertakings active in a variety of sectors, including ingredients for plastic production;
- for BorsodChem: production of certain plastics and plastic ingredients.
